

## **Landscape Collage Quilt: Supply and Pre-Class Prep**

You will need to bring to class :

Sewing machine ( which will lower feed dogs ) in good working order

Darning or free motion foot/or walking foot for straight stitch quilting

Thread to match or compliment your scenery

Cutting mat with rotary cutter

Scissors

Straight pins or quilting pins

Fabric Scraps :

Dark to lights in all the colors: Any size scraps, but plenty of them OR and 1/8<sup>th</sup> yard in landscape colors to be cut

Blue, Green, Purple, Tan, White, Yellow (your choice of colors for a landscape )

Reds or whichever color you would like for the Tulip

Binding Fabric : Cut 2-2 1/2" strips (cut WOF from 42-45" width fabric) or cut 1 – 1 5/8" strip and 1 -1 1/4" strip (WOF) for double binding

**Please note : \$6. Fee payable to the instructor the day of class** : includes, tulle, batting, backing and pattern for the tulip and directions for the bordered binding

**Pre-Class Prep** : if you are familiar with making a quilt binding, you could prepare your binding before class so that you may possibly be ready to add them to your quilt. Or you can just pre-cut your binding strips and Dan will demonstrate how he finishes binding.
