



Daisy Table Runner

I made my table runner with 6 blocks, 2 small borders and 2 long borders. You can make yours the same or shorter or longer. These designs are very customizable. You might want to wait till you've made a few blocks to decide on borders. The daisy blocks fabric listed is for **one** block. Multiply these numbers by the number of blocks you want to make.

FABRIC - DAISY BLOCKS EACH

Fabric A- Cut 1 7"x 7" - top background

Fabric B- Cut 1 7"x 4" - bottom background

Fabric C- Cut 1 7"x 7" - daisy

Small pieces of fabric for the applique – flower center

Border Fabric D - ½ yd

Fabric E- backing (cut later - measure your joined panels first)

Batting - 1 yd of a flat cotton or polyester batting

Design files - these will be distributed in the class and a design fee of \$12.50 plus tax will be collected

Sewing machine with embroidery module and a 5x7 or larger hoop

Sewing machine manual if you're not familiar with your machine

Embroidery threads to match or contrast with fabrics

Embroidery bobbin thread

Cutaway stabilizer

Sewing thread and bobbin

Small curved applique scissors

Blue wash away marker or chalk

Rotary cutter and ruler (6x12 or similar is a good size)

Usual sewing supplies
