## Class Supply List

An email with VERY specific instructions for preparing for the first class will be sent to you before class. Please be sure we have your current email address (or phone number) when you register for class so we can get this information to you. Please complete the preparation BEFORE class.

- Sewing machine in good working condition (please let us know when you register for class if you would like to use one of our classroom machines for this class)
- **Boxy Tote pattern from Quilts Illustrated #ps056** (each student is required to have their own original copy of the pattern in class)\*
- **Fabric requirements:**\*
  - 1 yard for **Fabric A:** for outer end pockets, handle and outer bag front and back
  - 1 1/3 yards for **Fabric B:** for outer bag ends, inner bag ends, outer bag front and back pockets, and inner front and back
  - 1 yard for **Fabric C:** for inner end pockets, inner front and back pockets, outer bag end pocket linings, outer bag front and back pocket linings

**NOTE: you can swap any pieces that fit, but be sure to cut the larger pieces first!**

- 1/2 yard Pellon Thermolam\*
- 1 Bosal In-R-Form single sided fusible foam\*
- 1/3 yard Peltex\*
- 30" purse zipper with 2 slides\* (it is quite prominent in the finished bag appearance, so choose your color accordingly). A separating zipper is NOT necessary.
- **Zipper foot:** if you have a BERNINA, the #4 or #4D foot\*
- **Edgestitch foot:** if you have a BERNINA, the #10, #10C or #10D foot\*
- **Overlock foot:** if you have a BERNINA, the #2 or #2A foot\*
- **Threads\*** to match your fabric—there is a lot of quilting and topstitching.
- **Basic sewing supplies:**\* scissors, regular size pins and heavier pins, size 90/14 to 100/16 topstitch machine needles, Wonder Clips from Clover are also helpful for this project, fabric marking pen or pencil that will show on your fabric, and your usual basic sewing supplies.

Items marked with an asterisk (\*) are regularly available in the store. If there is something we are out of or don't normally stock but that you need, please ask us—we are happy to do a special order for you! (Please remember special orders can take some time so let us know well in advance of class day!) Please mark or tag all your tools with your name so that if they are left in class we can return them to you!
