

French Roses Quilt

Class Supply List

Please complete the following class preparation BEFORE class day so that you can make the most of your time with the instructor. If you have questions about the class prep work, please visit us in the Longmont store or call BEFORE class day so that we can help you.

Please read the pattern thoroughly so that you have a general idea of what we will be doing. Don't get overwhelmed by details, we will simplify in class—just read through it so you get the idea.

Decide on what size quilt you will be making. Use 9 1/2" squares for the flower blocks and then add 8" for borders so that you have a ballpark idea of the finished size. For example, I wanted to make a baby quilt so I used 3 blocks across and 4 blocks down, plus the borders. This ends up to be a 45" x 54" finished quilt.

Once you decide on your design / size, you will know how many flower blocks you need. Cut out that number of 10" squares from your background fabric. (We will trim the final blocks to 9 1/2" in class.)

Cut out your flower templates from your desired template material (plastic or cardboard). Tip: make several paper copies of the template from the original pattern so that you have extras if you need them. This step is only for getting your templates ready for class, we will cut out your flower fabrics in class.

- **Sewing machine*** in good working condition (please let us know if you would like to use one of our classroom machines for this class)
- **French Roses*** pattern from Heather French (each student is required to bring their own original copy of the pattern to class)
- **Fabric:*** (taken from the pattern information: "Yardage requirements are generous" using 42" wide fabric.)
 - Background squares and outer border: 2 and 2/3 yards
 - Flowers, inner border and binding: 3/4 yard each of 5 different coordinating fabric for the flowers
 - Leaves: fat eighth (approx. 9" x WOF or 42")
 - Backing: 4 yards
 - Batting: depends on width of batting purchased, but for a 57" x 57" quilt you will need a piece of batting that is 64" x 64"
- **Thread** (neutral color recommended for piecing)*
- **Patchwork piecing foot / 1/4" piecing foot** (if you have a BERNINA, the #37, #37D, #57, #57D, #97 or #97D foot)*
- **Applique foot** (if you have a BERNINA, we suggest the #20, #20C, #20D, #34, #34C, #34D, #23 or whatever is your favorite foot for applique)*
- **Rotary cutter, ruler and mat*** (some are available for you to share in class, you may prefer to bring your own because of the constant trimming and pressing involved with this project. It will be VERY helpful for you to have class sized pressing

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mat, travel iron, rotary cutting mat and rotary cutter that you can set up beside you.) You will also need a 24" x 6 1/2" rotary cutting ruler.

- **Travel size iron and pressing mat*** are helpful for this project.
- **Scissors:*** sharp applique scissors, and craft scissors to cut your templates from the plastic (or cardboard) template material
- **Template material:*** template plastic or sturdy cardboard.
- **Marking pens:*** temporary and permanent.
- **Basic sewing supplies:** scissors, glass head pins, fabric marking pen or pencil, tape measure, etc.*

Items marked with an asterisk (*) are regularly available in the store. If there is something we are out of or don't normally stock but that you need, please ask us—we are happy to do a special order for you! (Please remember special orders can take some time so let us know well in advance of class day!)

Please mark or tag all your tools with your name so that if they are left in class we can return them to you!
