## Class Supply List

In order for you to have the best class experience and make the most of your class time with the instructor and complete as much of your project as possible, please cut the fabric as instructed on page two of this supply list BEFORE class day. If you have any questions please let the instructor know before class day so that she can assist you.

- **Sewing machine** in good working condition (please let us know when you register for class if you would like to use one of our classroom machines for this class).
- **Patchwork piecing / 1/4" piecing foot\***: if you have a BERNINA, the #37, #37D, #57, #57D, #97 or #97D foot
- **Walking foot\*** (required—this is a “quilt as you go” technique class, so you will be quilting in class)
- **Peek a Boo\*** pattern from GE Designs (each student is required to bring their own original pattern to class)
- **Fabric and batting requirements:\***
  - **one charm pack** (20 or more pre-cut 5” squares—for variety, or you can cut your own 5” squares)
  - **background fabric: 1/2 yard**
  - **backing fabric: 1/3 yard**
  - **batting: 1/3 yard of fusible batting** (or non-fusible batting and 505 Temporary Spray Adhesive as an alternative)
  - **binding: 1/4 yard**
- **Thread\*** a neutral color for piecing (will not be seen) and a color to match or contrast your fabric(s) for the topstitching where you will see your thread
- **Basic sewing supplies:\*** scissors, glass head pins, fabric marking pen or pencil that will show on your fabric, seam ripper, measuring tape, sewing machine needles, etc., rotary cutter with new sharp blade, rotary cutting ruler (6” x 24” recommended but smaller can work)—we have some rotary cutting mats you may share in class or you may bring your own if you prefer.

Items marked with an asterisk (\*) are regularly available in the store. If there is something we are out of or don't normally stock but that you need, please ask us—we are happy to do a special order for you! (Please remember special orders can take some time so let us know well in advance of class day!) Please mark or tag all your tools with your name so that if they are left in class we can return them to you!

# Cutting

Label each set of pieces as you cut so that you will know what size they are when you go to assemble your table runner.

- Charm Squares:

- Cut one square that is 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" for the center of the table runner—you may want to fussy cut a motif
- Cut 12 rectangles that are 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- Cut 6 squares that are 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- Cut 10 squares that are 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

- Background Fabric:

- Cut two strips that are 4 1/2" x WOF (width of fabric, assuming 40" wide) and then SUBCUT these strips into:
  - 24 rectangles that are 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"
  - 4 rectangles that are 4 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- Cut 1 strip that is 2 1/2" x WOF and then SUBCUT that strip into:
  - 12 squares that are 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- Cut 2 strips that are 1 1/2" x WOF and then SUBCUT these strips into:
  - 12 rectangles that are 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"

- Backing Fabric:

- Cut one piece that is 11" x 38" for the backing

- Batting:

- Cut one piece that is 11" x 38" for the batting
