Class Supply List

An email with VERY specific instructions for preparing for the first class will be sent to you before class. Please be sure we have your current email address (or phone number) when you register for class so we can get this information to you. Please complete the preparation BEFORE class.

- Sewing machine in good working condition (please let us know when you register for class if you would like to use one of our classroom machines for this class)
- *Sling Along* pattern from Studio Kat Designs (each student is required to have their own original copy of the pattern in class)*
- Fabric requirements:* (note: extra fabric may be required if you choose directional prints)
 - Exterior Fabric: 1/2 yard
 - Lining: 7/8 yard
 - Contrast: 1/2 yard
- 1/8 yard Pellon Decor Bond fusible interfacing*
- 1/4 yard Pellon Thermolam or Fusible Fleece*
- 1/3 yard Bosal In-R-Form Fusible Foam*
- One 14" zipper*
- One 24" Handbag zipper
- One 1" wide side-release buckle (sometimes called a parachute clip)*
- Three 1" wide rectangle or D rings*
- One 1 1/2" slide buckle*
- One 1 1/2" wide swivel snap hook*
- 1 1/2 yards of nylon webbing that is 1 1/2" wide* (for straps—color does not matter, it will be covered)
- 1/3 yard of nylon webbing that is 1" wide* (for clip links—color does not matter)
- The pattern calls for sew-in magnetic snap—however, we will be using regular magnetic snaps. I have some colored snaps that you may have.

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- **We will be making our own bias tape in class**—there is no bias tape maker available in the size that we need.
- **Zipper foot:** if you have a BERNINA, the #4 or #4D foot*
- **Edgestitch foot:** if you have a BERNINA, the #10, #10C or #10D foot*
- **Patchwork piecing / 1/4” piecing foot:** if you have a BERNINA, the #37, #37D, #57, #57D, #97 or #97D foot*
- **Threads*** to match your fabric—there is a lot of quilting and topstitching.
- **Basic sewing supplies:*** scissors, regular size pins and heavier pins, Superior topstitch machine needles, Wonder Clips from Clover are also helpful for this project, fabric marking pen or pencil that will show on your fabric, and your usual basic sewing supplies.

Items marked with an asterisk (*) are regularly available in the store. If there is something we are out of or don't normally stock but that you need, please ask us—we are happy to do a special order for you! (Please remember special orders can take some time so let us know well in advance of class day!) Please mark or tag all your tools with your name so that if they are left in class we can return them to you!
