

### **Name of Class: Tucker University 1-401: Square Squared**

We appreciate if all necessary supplies are purchased at Material Girls. A class discount of 10% will be given on all class purchase. All necessary supplies can be found at Material Girls unless otherwise noted on the supply list.

#### **Objective:**

The Square Squared unit can be found within blocks as well as sashings. Since the unit is often used to connect other units, the points are extremely valuable for the design to work without interruption. You will save those points with the Square Squared tool. A secondary benefit to using Deb Tucker's method of creating Square Squared units is that you will not waste fabric. It's a win-win situation.

Expand the use of your Square Squared tool by learning how to make little houses. Little houses have been disguised in borders and have shown up in some star blocks. You will be astounded where these units show up.

#### **Fabric Requirements:**

¼ yard Focal Fabric

¼ yard Background

¼ yard of a coordinating or contrasting fabric with the focal fabric

\*Fabrics will be cut in class. Therefore, the fabric requirements are healthy amounts so that you can make your own design choices during class. You may even want to use some of your scraps from previous classes here.

#### **Required Tools: (You will receive all of these items on the day of class)**

Square Squared (if you own this ruler and have notified us at registration, please bring it. We will *not* have extras for borrowing)

#### **Basic Supplies:**

Quilters Magic Wand

Sewing machine with power cord, foot control, and a ¼" presser foot

50wt. Aurifil cotton thread

75/11 or 80/12 Microtex needle

Seam Ripper

Snips or trimming scissors

Rotary Cutter with a sharp blade

Marking Pencil

Small cutting mat (12x18 is plenty or 18x24) We have some mats in the class room but due to the large class size it can help if you have a mat for cutting at your desk and not have to wait for a space at the tables

Straight edge rotary ruler (6x12 should be fine)

Invisigrip or your preferred additional grip product for the back of rulers
