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
Traditional Faux Chenille Quilts |

Supplies Needed

- **Fabrics** - Cotton, homespun/yarn dyes, and flannels, all work very well when making chenille. These fabrics are loosely woven and tend to “bloom” very nicely. Panels works great too!
- **How many layers of fabric** — the number of layers used to make the chenille depends on the final project and your personal preference
 - I like 5 layers -
 - (1) for the back and (4) for the quilt top













A Modern Take on Chenille

What is Chenille-It?

AKA Blooming Bias

Chenille-It[®] is made with a fabric that will “bloom” with one layer in one wash.

You need about four layers of flannel to achieve what Chenille-It[®] does in one layer.



Blooming Bias


22 Colors in two different widths

3/8" and 5/8"

How does it work?

Cover the raw edge with the 3/8-inch-wide Chenille-It[®], stitching down the center of the tape. Just need to use one layer. The more layers the more fluff.


When you come to a corner, there is not a right or wrong side so you can just flip the tape and keep on going.




















Skip the binding!

Instead of binding the edge, just trim your edge, serge, or zig zag it to hold the layers together and sew the 5/8" Chenille-It[®] to the wrong side and then the right side of the quilt.
