

Santa Bag Supply List

Hi Ladies,

I'm looking forward to the Santa Bag class. It really is a fun project. The store will open at 9:30 for you to get set up. This project only calls for using a sewing machine, but I used my Solaris to embroider the beard. This is optional, but if you haven't used IQ designer or the scanner and projector this is a good time to learn.

You will need to purchase the pattern (embellishments included with pattern) and the fusible quick grid (sold at Flash). You do not need to purchase these items before the class on Sept. 13th.

Supply list: (refer to cutting chart below for fabric measurements)

- 6 to 8 red prints
- 1 or 2 flesh prints for the face
- 2 to 4 black prints for the belt
- 1 to 4 white prints for the beard
- 2/3 yard 45" fabric for the lining and handles
- 20" x 40" piece of batting
- 20" x 40" piece of scrap fabric for the backing. This fabric will not show in the bag.
- Threads to match fabrics
- Dual feed foot or walking foot
- All the usual sewing notions

If you would like to get a head start in cutting the squares, below is a list of squares and sizes. The reason for the larger 2 7/8" squares is because they will be made into half square triangles. This is optional, no need to stress if you don't have time.

1. Cut (60) 2 3/8" squares from a variety of red fabrics.
2. Cut (1) 2 7/8" square from one red fabric.
3. Cut (12) 2 7/8" squares from two to four different black fabrics.
4. Cut (6) 2 3/8" squares from one to four white fabrics.
5. Cut (1) 2 7/8" squares from white fabric.
6. Cut (2) 2 3/8" square from flesh fabric.
7. Cut (1) 2 7/8" square from flesh fabric
