

5th Avenue Serger Clutch

For 8-thread Babylock serger/cover/chain stitch machines with wave stitch

This serger clutch has all the details of a high fashion clutch and more. From the luxe fabrics to the decorative threads used as accents, this project is sure to be a hit. With techniques like decorative chain/cover stitch, flatlock wave, inserting a zipper and more.

MATERIALS LIST

You may substitute other fabrics for those suggested.

OUTSIDE FABRIC

- 1/3 yd Cotton Velveteen
- 3/4 yd Silk Dupioni (due to the direction of the gathers)
- 1/4 yd Cork
- 1 1/2" x WOF solid color quilting cotton for wave piping

INSIDE FABRIC –will show when clutch is open

- 1/3 yd linen blend

LINING FABRIC – will see when looking inside zipper pocket

- 1/3 yd quilting cotton

ULTRASOFT BLC204 cutaway stabilizer

- 1/3 yd.

- 1 – 16" zipper to coordinate with inside
- 1 – fancy button or sparkly brooch/button
- 2 – decorative threads *such as Sulky 12 wt cotton color 1046 solid & color 4110 blendable*)

WHAT TO CUT

Measurements are tall and wide in case of directional fabric like velveteen and dupioni silk.

OUTSIDE FABRIC

- 1 – 12" x 12" cotton velveteen (cross hatching)
- 1 – 6" x 11" black cork (flap)
- 1 – 26" x 2 1/2" silk (puffing)
- 1 - 1 1/2" x WOF cotton (wave piping)

INSIDE FABRIC

- 1 – 6" x 11"

LINING FABRIC

- 1 – 6" x 11"
- 1 – 11" x 11"
- 1 – 12" x 10"

ULTRASOFT (used as interfacing)

- 1 – 12" x 11"



Presser Feet

- Standard or Clear Foot
- Quilting Guide Bar
- Curve Foot
- Chain/Cover Foot
- Cording Foot, 5mm

General sewing supplies, including small 'quilt clips'
