Class Overview:

Have fun creating a beautiful quilt top by learning the following:

- Cut fabrics accurately
- How to square-up your HST's accurately
- How to snowball corners
- Cut sashing strips to size of block
- Half Square Triangles (HST's)

What to bring:

- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
 - o Thread / bobbins / spare needles
 - o ¼" foot
 - o Pins
 - o Rotary cutter (45 or 60mm) / extra blade
 - o Scissors, seam ripper
 - o Small iron / pressing mat (some irons available in classroom)
 - o Cutting mat – 18x24 recommended (some available in classroom)
- **Rulers**
 - o 6.5" x 24" or similar ruler & a Square ruler (at least 7.5" or larger)
 - o or Stripology Squared or XL ruler
 - If using stripology ruler – stickers will make your cuts faster & more accurate
 - I am not a certified stripology instructor, but I use them all the time. I am happy to demonstrate how I use them.

 - o **Fabric:** See pattern for fabric requirements
 - Fabric Café patterns are designed to efficiently use 44" by width of fabric. **A 'single fold' binding is used.**
 - ***You will need to buy an extra ½ yard of your light fabric – if you want to use 2.5" strips to create a 'double-fold' binding.***

Pre-work: Press your fabrics before class to save time.
