

# Foundation Paper Piecing Class

## 12" Hunter's Star Block

**Materials List:** The Hunter's Star block requires two fabrics, one light and one dark.

Light fabric: at least 1/4 yard x 44" wide

Dark fabric: at least 1/4 yard x 44" wide.

All-purpose sewing thread

80/12 Universal Needle, *or needle type of your choice*

Water-soluble glue stick

Rotary cutter, mat and acrylic ruler (*cutting mats are in classroom*)

12 1/2" quilters square

Pencil

Sewing machine and general sewing supplies

Presser foot: General purpose or an open toe foot.

Optional: 1/4" quilter's presser foot

Optional: Iron and pressing mat (*irons and ironing boards are available in the classroom.*)

Paper piecing pattern for Hunter's Star 12" block, (*will be provided in class*)



For Quilt-As-You-Go (QAYG) you will also need

At least a 13" square of backing fabric

At least a 13" square of batting

Quilting thread of choice

Quilting needle of choice

Optional: quilting temporary spray adhesive

Note: we will not be quilting the block in class but we can put together the quilt 'sandwich' so it is ready to be quilted.

### Preparation for Class

Pre-washing fabrics is optional. Do **starch and press fabrics** so they are fairly 'crisp' feeling. Cut your fabric as follows and bring the cut pieces to class. It is a good idea to label the cut pieces A through F as indicated below. **NOTE:** *The cut dimensions below are minimum sizes. Fabric pieces can be larger and any shape. They will be trimmed to correct dimensions after they are sewn.*

Light fabric cut:

- 4 "A" pieces each 2 1/2" x 6",
- 8 "B" pieces each 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- 4 "C" pieces 4" x 7"

Dark fabric cut:

- 4 "D" pieces each 2 1/2" x 6",
- 8 "E" pieces each 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- 4 "F" pieces 4" x 7"
