Class Overview: Have you wanted to make your own quilted jacket but it felt too intimidating. This class takes away the fear of another WIP (Work in Progress) that goes into the stack of PHD (Project Half Done). Do you have orphan blocks or a set of fat eighths or fat quarters that you are dying to use and a sweatshirt? You are halfway there! Use them to create your own quilted jacket. You will be amazed at what you create.

You can arrive at the Charlotte Sewing Center at 10:00 am to set up your station. We will begin promptly at 10:30 am. You may bring a lunch and/or snacks/drinks to class as we do not take a formal lunch break.

Required Class Supplies:

- Beachcomber Jacket pattern by Laundry Basket Quilts
https://www.laundrybasketquilts.com/products/212373856?pr_prod_strat=e5_desc&pr_rec_id=8ffe403ce&pr_rec_pid=9675016667412&pr_ref_pid=9675039277332&pr_seq=uniform.
- Sweatshirt at least one size larger than you usually wear. (If you are going to line your jacket, consider two sizes larger.)
- Fabric (If you are not going to use orphan blocks)
 - 30 fat eighths (9" x 20") of multi-color dark fabric
 - 7 quarter yards (9" x WOF) of light fabric
 - 2 ½ yards of lining (if desired)
 - ¼ yard dark fabric for binding
 - 1 white fat quarter
 - 2 ¼ yards background fabric
 - 1 ¾ yards backing fabric
 - ½ yard binding fabric
- Sewing machine in good working order.

Required General Sewing supplies:

- o 1/4" presser foot - to ensure an accurate 1/4" seam
- o Rotary cutter with new blade inserted (45mm or 60mm with retractable blade)
- o Sewing machine in good working order, thread, extra bobbins and needles.
- o Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, extra bobbins, etc.)

What to do before class (homework)

- o Purchase sweatshirt and fabric
- o Gather orphan blocks

Recommended: *Clean your machine before a class (and on a regular basis). A clean machine works more efficiently and helps avoid machine issues while in class. Also, a new needle in the machine and a new blade in the rotary cutter add to your success with a new project.*

A reminder email will be issued by the instructor 2 weeks prior to the class. *An automated class reminder is also issued from Charlotte Sewing Center.*
