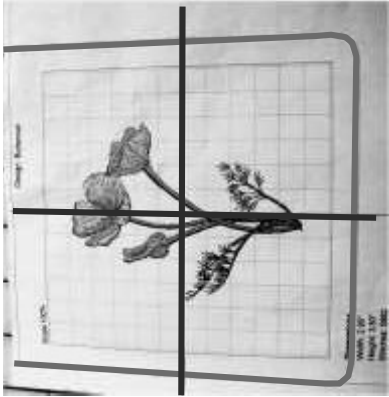


How to use a Printed Placement Template

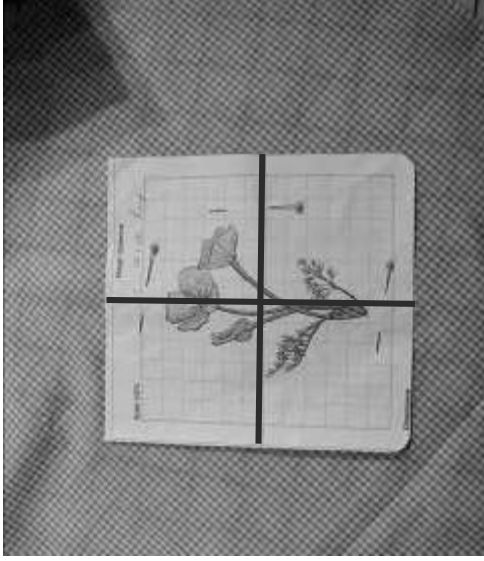

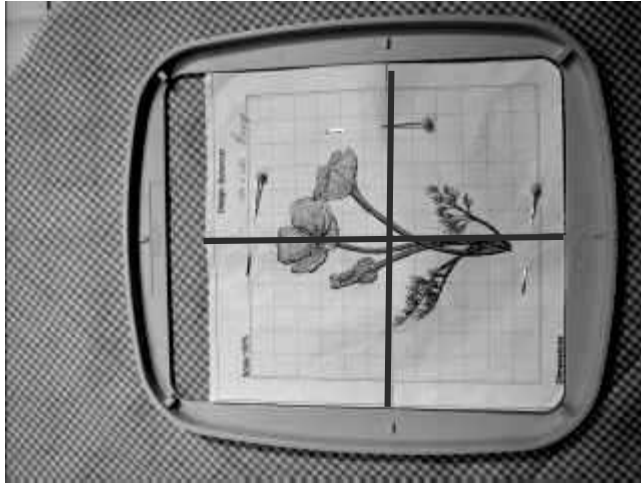
Trace around the inside of the hoop.
Extend the center lines.



Cut out the hoop shape.



Place the template on the project, position the designs exactly where it is to stitch out and pin it in place. Put stabilizer behind the project fabric.



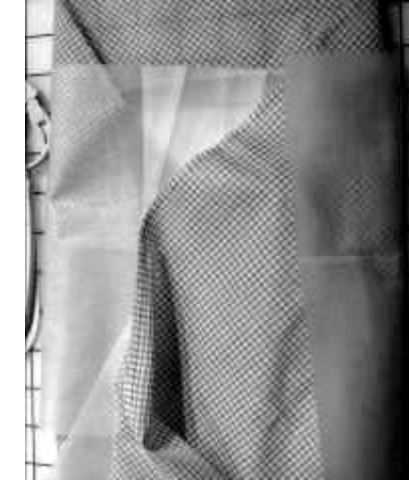
Place the inner hoop on the project, fitting it to the template and matching the center lines with the centering marks on the hoop.



Put strips of two sided tape on the backside of the inner hoop. The tackiness will help hold the hoop to the project fabric.



Unfold the fabric. Make any necessary minor adjustments. Tighten the outer hoop screw so the project is held securely in the hoop.



Fold the project fabric and stabilizer over the inner hoop so you can pick it up without disturbing the template and hoop placement.



Place it inside the outer hoop.

Keep the template in place until the hoop is on the machine and the design position has been checked at the machine. Remove the template and start to embroider.
