

Materials and Supplies List – Flowers in Watering Can Applique Block

Fabrics:

These do not need to be cut precisely to these dimensions as all will be cut down further. These are minimum sizes required.

- Watering Can – 11" x 7"
- Flowers 1 and 2 – 4 ½" x 4", each
- Centers 1 and 2 – 1 ½" square, each OR 1 ½" x 3" for both centers.
- Buds 1 and 2 – 2 ½ x 3 ½" each
- Bud 3 – 2" x 3"
- 13" fabric square for background
- 13" fabric square for backing
- Fabric scraps for testing various stitches.

Threads:

- Green embroidery thread for stems.
- Embroidery thread of choice for small round flowers attached to stems. Mine are purple.
- Embroidery threads to match or coordinate with each fabric chosen for flowers, flower centers and watering can.
- White Bobbin thread (pre-wound bobbin recommended)
Note: 'Bobbin thread' is a lighter weight thread, typically 60 wt, used for embroidery. Alternatively, a general-purpose sewing thread (50 wt) can be used.
- Thread for quilting. This should be in a color that coordinates with the background fabric. It can be cotton quilting thread, embroidery thread or general-purpose sewing thread.

Other:

- Fusible adhesive web (e.g., Heat-N-Bond). **This will be available in class.**
- Batting – 13" square
- Light weight tear away stabilizer – 13" square. **This will be available in class.**
- **Teflon applique sheet OR parchment paper, a piece about 11" square or larger.**

Fabric marker(s) – water soluble, air soluble or chalk pencil

Sewing machine. Open toe presser foot or decorative stitches presser foot is recommended in addition to the general-purpose foot. *A decorative stitches foot comes with most machines; open toe foot is usually an optional purchase.* Paper and fabric scissors as well as general sewing supplies.
