General Information

Yankee Pride is now offering the Winter 2023/Spring 2024 schedule of classes for Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced students. In addition to offering expert and experienced teachers, we are also pleased to offer each student a 20% discount on all class materials, excluding the Mystery Quilt classes. Class descriptions include the discounted price for any needed books or patterns.

Cancellation Policy

Any class may be cancelled if there is not the minimum number of students five days before the class is scheduled to begin. Refunds will be given to all students at that time. No refunds can be given thereafter.

Class Supply List and Yardage

Supply lists are provided online in the class description. Yardage for specific classes may be given to students if the class has previously been taught at Yankee Pride. Yardage for new classes will not be available until the initial class meeting. Students who purchase their fabric and class supplies before the first class do so at their own risk. Yankee Pride cannot be responsible if the class is cancelled due to low enrollment.

Note: Unless otherwise specified, all classes include all directions needed to complete the projects.

Introduction to Quilting

with Ruth Julianelle

[Beginner]

Learn the fundamentals of quilting in this class. You will complete two projects: a pillowcase, and a baby or lap-sized quilt. Topics discussed are the parts of a quilt, materials used, basic block construction (including seams and pressing), assembling the quilt top, and finishing techniques. Class fee patterns and copy of class notes. Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 sessions have been scheduled for your convenience.

Learn how to make accurate quilt blocks using both standard and fast-piecing techniques. Studio 180 rulers will be used. By the end of class, you will have made a twin-sized sampler quilt. The class covers instruction on the blocks, sashing, and borders. Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 sessions have been scheduled for your convenience. [Minimum of 3 students; maximum of 8]

This 2-part thread painting workshop is designed for quilters and other textile artists who are interested in creating exquisite texture and detail in their work through combining hand and machine stitching.

Students should already have experience with free motion stitching, and some basic knowledge of hand embroidery. 10-hour class over 2 sessions.

Do you own one or more Studio 180 Design rulers but are not sure how to use them? Have you ever wondered what more they can do beyond their original intent? This series with Joan Shortsleeve, Certified Studio 180 Instructor, will cover several rulers that most of us have in our sewing spaces.

Tucker Trimmer I *with Joan Shortsleeve*

[Confident Beginner]

Joan will show you how to make multiple half square triangles at one time, hourglass blocks, combination and non-mirror blocks, shaded four patch, as well as more about half square triangles. Ruler and Technique Sheets are required for class.

Wing Clipper *with Joan Shortsleeve*

Joan will show you how to make Flying Geese (2 1/2 x 4 1/2), Identical Flying Geese (2 1/2 x 4 1/2), Flying Geese Log Cabin, Picket Fences (2 1/2 x 4 1/2). Ruler and Technique Sheets are required for class.

Rapid Fire Hunter's Star – Petite Star*with Joan Shortsleeve*

[Confident Beginner]

Joan will show you how to make these traditionally difficult blocks with ease using the Rapid-Fire Hunter's Star tool since it allows for more streamlined construction and precision trim down. Ruler is required for class.

Wedge Star *with Joan Shortsleeve*

[Confident Beginner]

Hesitant to try a pattern with diamonds? Joan will show you how to create beautiful designs using the Wedge Ruler, a 45-degree angle ruler. The units she will cover are the Wedge Star, Wedge Block, Mixed Block, and Diamond Four Patch. Ruler and Technique Sheet are required for class.

Square Squared Half Inch *with Joan Shortsleeve*

[Confident Beginner]

Joan will show you how to perfect your Square in a Square blocks. This is an all-in-one tool that gives you a window template for accurately cutting the center square, a chart printed on the ruler to cut the triangles sewn to the four sides of the center square, and a trim down section that simplifies the alignment of the ruler to allow everyone to clean up the unit to a precise measurement every time. Ruler and Technique Sheet are required for class.

Star 60 with Joan Shortsleeve

[Confident Beginner]

Do you avoid hexagons or 60-degree angles? Joan will show you how easy these blocks can be using this ruler. She will show you how to make a basic Square 60 unit, as well as making hexagons and a Hollow Cube (Studio 180's Tumbling Block). Ruler and Technique Sheet are required for class.
