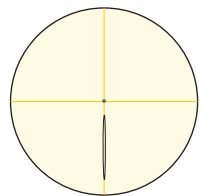
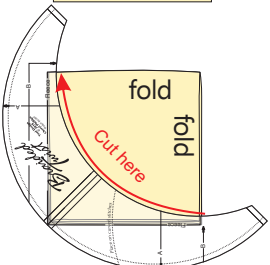
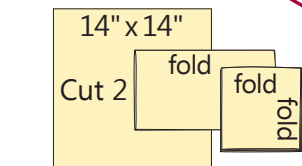


When the two circles are sewn together and turned to the right side, measure the diameter.

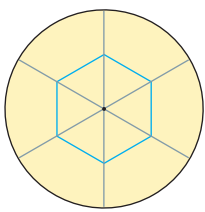
Trace the correctly sized hexagon onto the side with the slit.

Draw lines as shown, extending them to the edge of the circle.

- ← 12 1/2" diameter
- ← 12 1/4" diameter
- ← 12" diameter

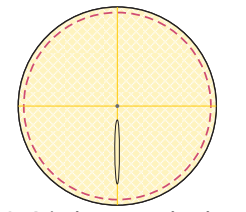


3. Turn to the right side.



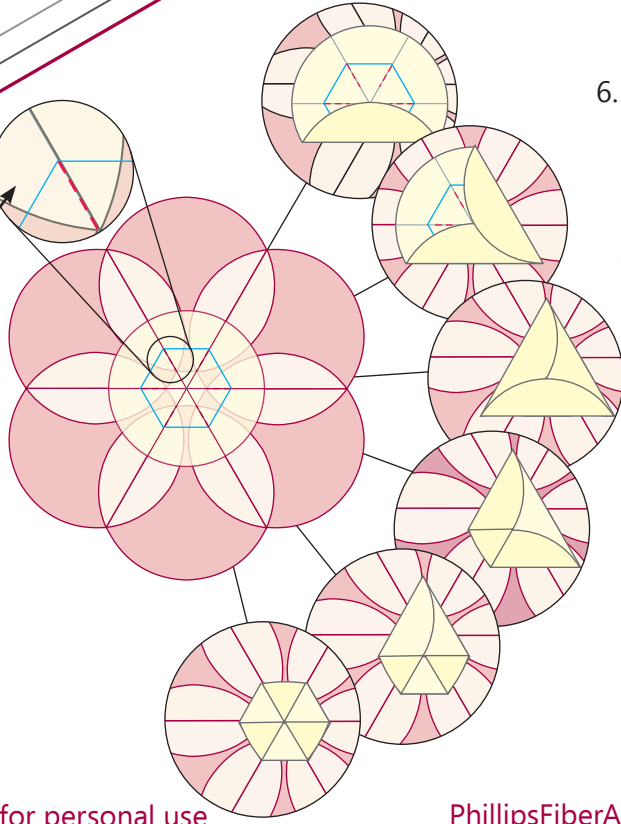
4. Measure the circle. Center and trace a hexagon.

1. Cut along the inside curved edge for a 13" circle.



2. Stitch around edge. Cut a slit for turning.

5. Align the markings to the seams. Stitch along the lines. The stitching attaches the circle to the flower.



6. Fold every other side to the center point.

7. Fold the points to the center point.

8. Hand stitch at the center to hold the layers in place.
