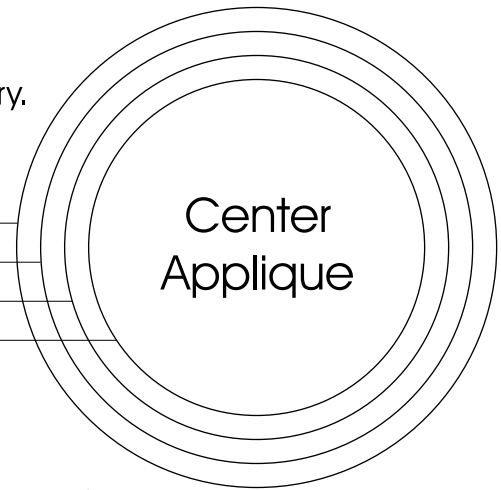
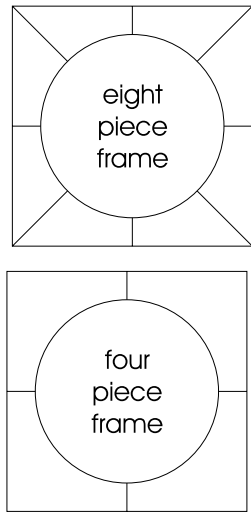


The template is designed for a circle measuring 27".
 Measure the completed circle and adjust the curve as necessary.

Measure the opening of your quilt center.
 Stabilize the opening from the back with a piece of freezer paper.
 Trace the template pattern about a half an inch larger than the opening.
 Cut out the freezer paper pattern.
 Iron the shiny side to the wrong side of the fabric center.
 Cut the fabric 1/4" larger than the paper.
 Apply glue to the paper's edge with a fabric basting glue stick.
 Turn the fabric over the edge and glue in place.
 Applique by hand or machine.
 Remove the paper from the fabric.



For an eight piece frame, cut here.

For a four piece frame, place on fold

Fold to divide the frame into eight sections.
 Match each eighth to three wedges and pin.
 Sew the frame to the circle using 1/4" seams,
 with the frame on top and the circle against
 the bed of the sewing machine.
