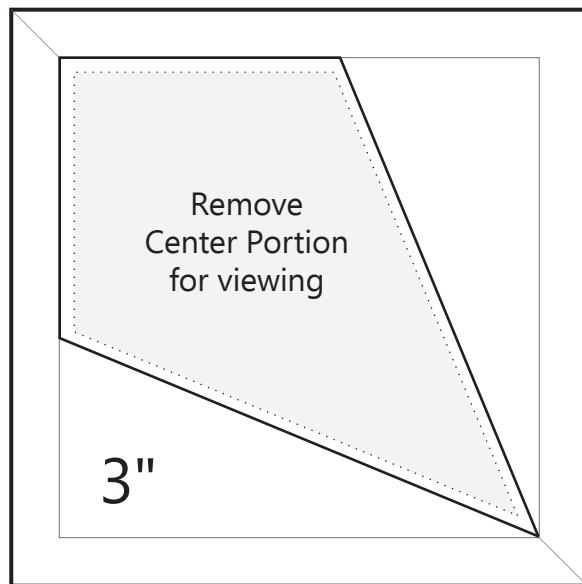
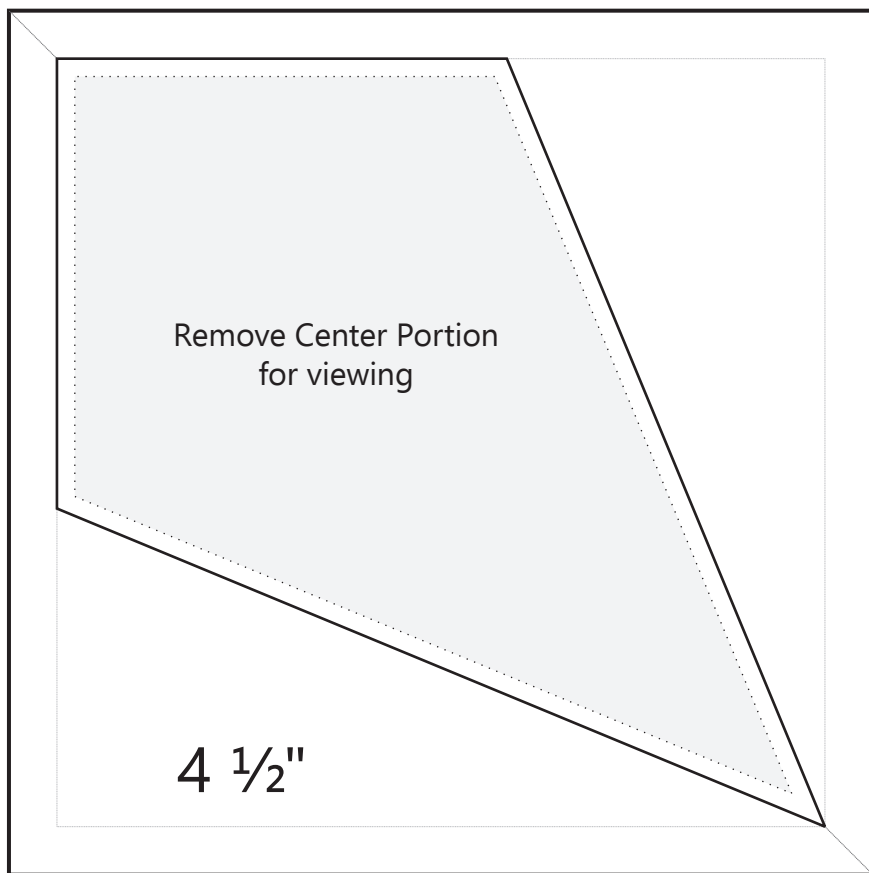
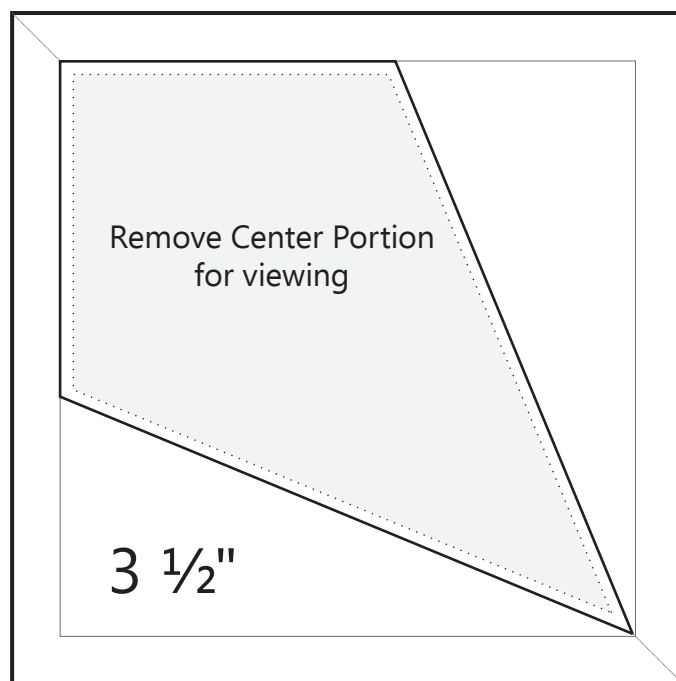
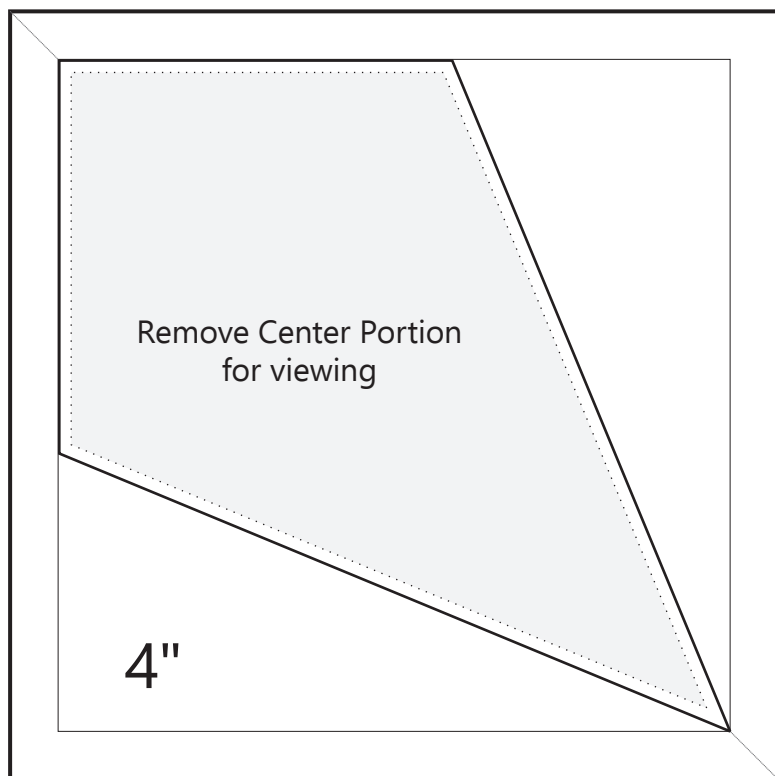


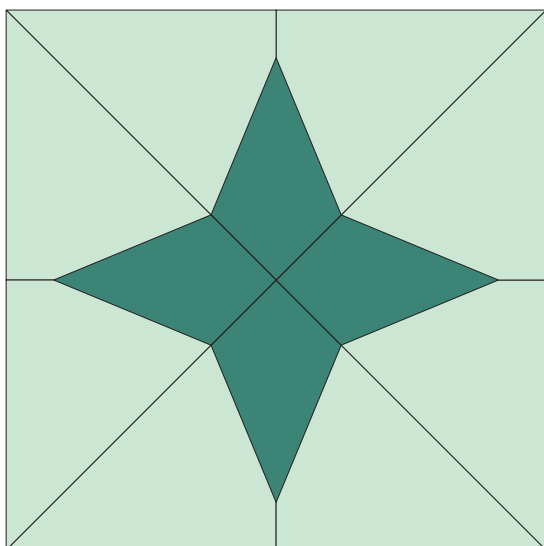
Folk Star Viewers



Cut away the paper in the center to make a Folk Star Viewer (Refer to video.)

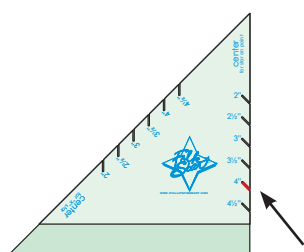
Center a motif in the open area and fussy cut the design square. This is the area that will be visible when making a Folk Star.





Star On Point

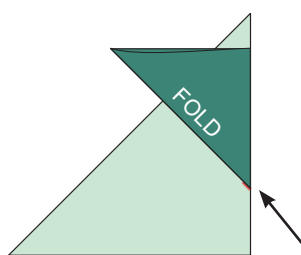

Step One

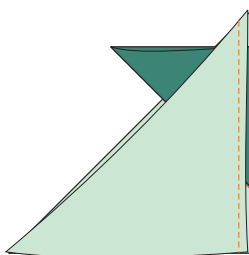
- Place the background triangle right side up.
- Align the tip of the tool "Place on Star Point" as shown.
- Choose the line matching the size of your star square.
- Mark a line in the slot using a mechanical pencil.

NOTE: Mark on the *shorter* side of the triangle for a *Star On Point*.



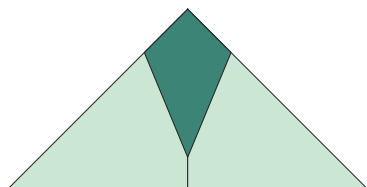
Step Two

- Fold the Star Square in half diagonally, wrong sides together, right sides out.
- Place the folded star piece directly onto the marked line. Precision is critical.



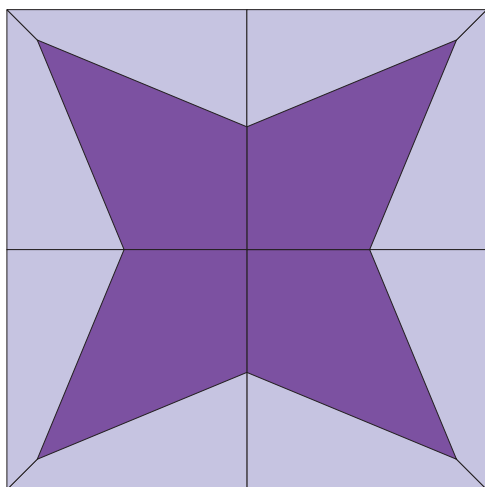
Step Three

- Place the other background triangle on top.
- Pin the sandwich together.
- Sew with an exact ¼" seam.



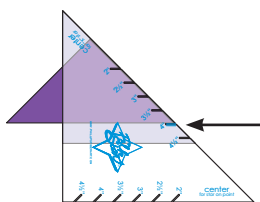
Step Four

- Open the folded pin.
- Press flat.
- Repeat for four pieces.
- Sew to make the block.



X Star

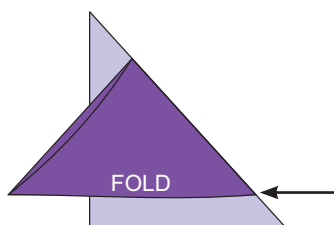

4 ½"	5"	8 ¼"
4"	4 ½"	7 ¼"
3 ½"	4"	6 ¼"
3"	3 ½"	5 ¼"
2 ½"	3"	4 ¾"
2"	2 ½"	3 ¾"



Step One

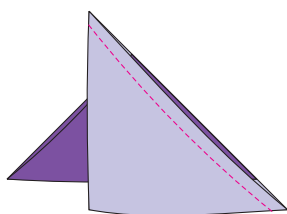
- Place the background triangle right side up.
- Align the tip of the tool "X Star" as shown.
- Choose the line matching the size of your star square.
- Mark a line in the slot using a mechanical pencil.

NOTE: Mark on the **longest** side of the triangle for an **X Star**.



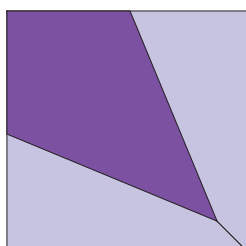
Step Two

- Fold the Star Square in half diagonally, wrong sides together, right sides out.
- Place the folded star piece directly onto the marked line. Precision is critical.



Step Three

- Place the other background triangle on top.
- Pin the sandwich together.
- Sew with an exact ¼" seam.



Step Four

- Open the folded pin.
- Press flat.
- Repeat for four pieces.
- Sew to make the block.
