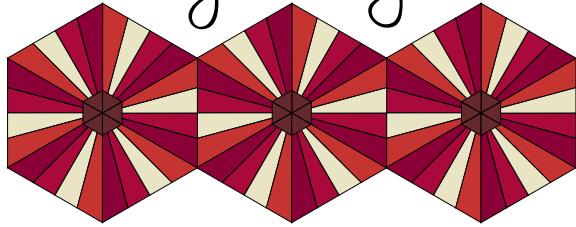


Holiday Hexagons

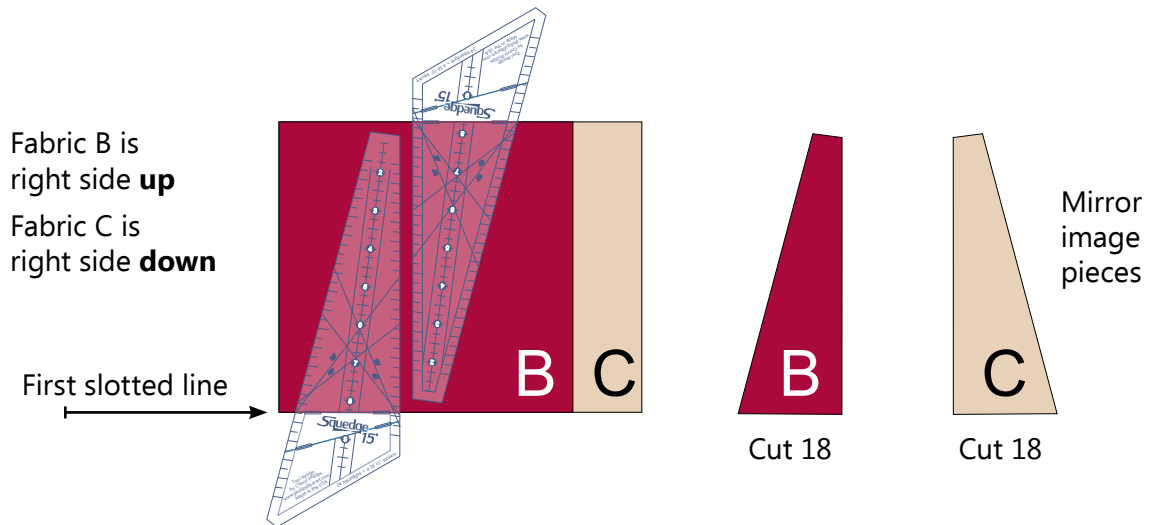


Finished Size: 18" x 47"

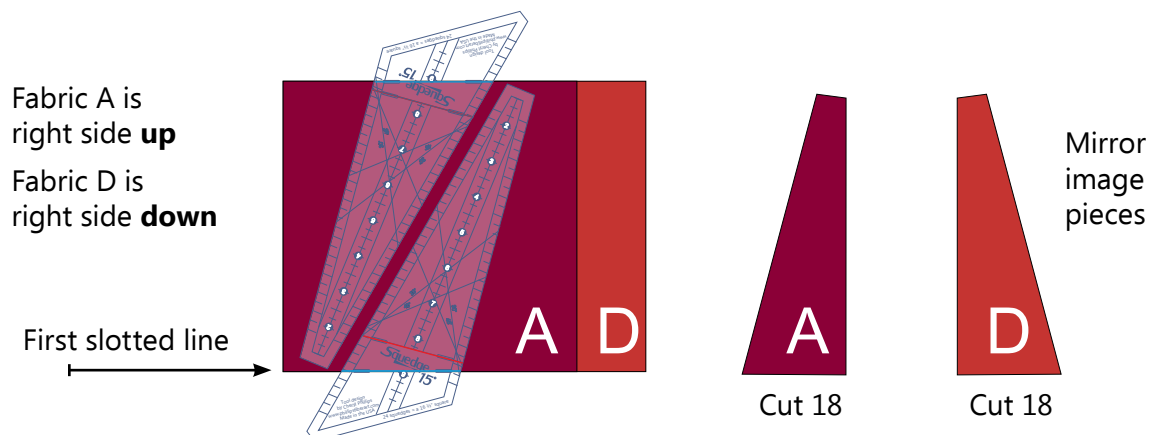
Fabric	Suggested Yardage	Cutting
A	¼ yd	one 7 ½" strip
B	¼ yd	one 7 ¼" strip
C	¼ yd	one 7 ¼" strip
D	¼ yd	one 7 ½" strip
E	⅛ yd	one 2 ½" strip
Backing	¾ yd	21" x 50"
Binding	⅜ yd	four 2 ½" strips

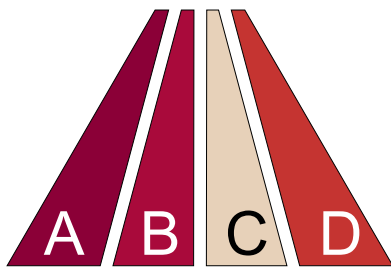
Cutting Squedge Pieces

- Do not leave the fabric strips folded. Open the strips and press to remove the fold.
- Place the 7 ½" B and C fabrics together, wrong sides facing. In other words B is right side up, but C is right side down.
- Place the first slotted line of the Squedge tool on the edge of the two strips.
- Cut around the sides and top for ONE Squedge piece.
- STOP! Double check to see that you have **mirror image** Squedges before you continue.
- Once you're sure they're right, cut 18 of each piece.

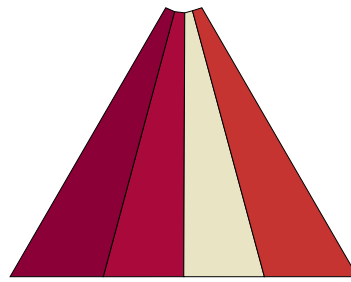


- Place the 7 ½" A and D fabrics together, wrong sides facing. A is right side up, but D is right side down.
- Place the second slotted line of the Squedge tool on the edge of the two strips.
- Cut around the sides and top for ONE Squedge piece.
- STOP and double check to see that you have **mirror image** Squedges before you continue.
- Once you're sure they're right, cut 18 of each piece.



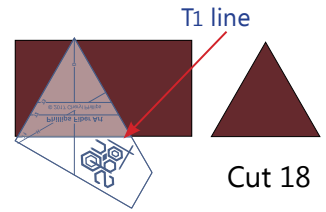


Arrange the Squedge pieces in order.



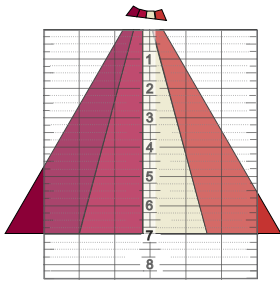
Sew the Squedge pieces together.

Place the Spot On tool's T-1 line on the edge of the 2 1/2" E Fabric strip. Cut 18 triangle tippers

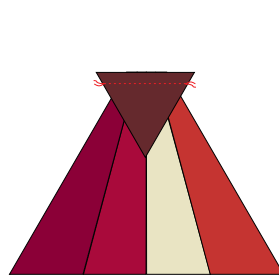


Cut 18

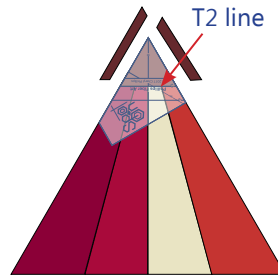
Place the 7" line of a ruler onto the bottom of the unit.



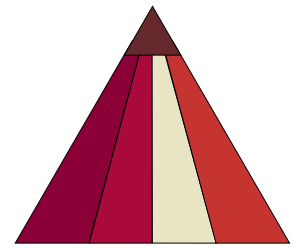
Trim away the curved portion.



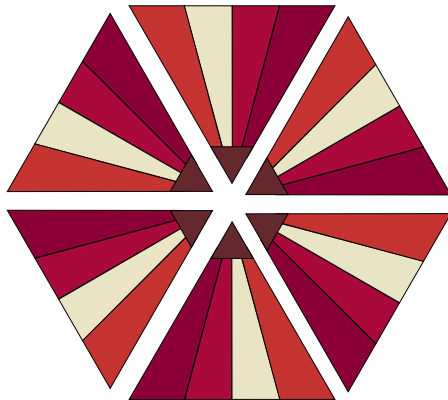
Center an E fabric triangle onto the top. Sew to the unit.



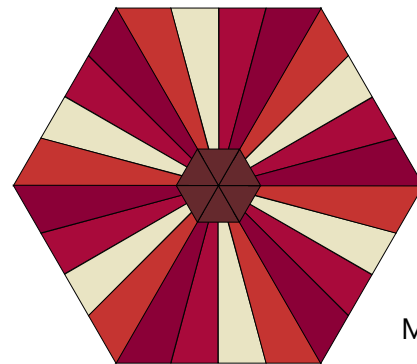
Trim the excess E fabric triangle using the Spot On tool.



Make 18



Arrange the Squedge units.



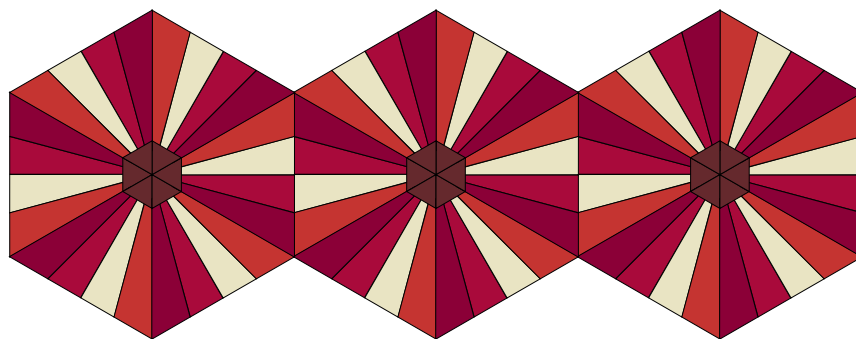
Make 18

Sew the Squedge units into a hexagon.

Sew three hexagons together to make a runner.

- Layer.
- Quilt.
- Bind.

This runner can also be finished by pillow-casing it with a backing fabric.
