

This is our first official free pattern using two different Squedges!! You'll need the Squedge 30 and the Squedge 15. Now find out how fun they are to mix and match!


*Cut into 3 ¼" squares then in half diagonally for corners. See page 3 for instructions on adding corners.

Tool Preparation

Apply adhesive non-slip rings to both the back and front side of the tool. You need to have these on both sides as you'll be cutting pieces with the tool flipped over.


Fabric C Suggestion

The Squedge 30 is a great tool for fussy cutting, so look for a fun patriotic print and select a design to repeat. If you prefer, you can use a solid reading blue and applique the three stars as shown above.



Always Sew with Exact ¼" Seams 11 ½" A



Place the tool on the strip set vertically. Rotate the tool to get second cut. Cut 8 of the *full* tool shape. Place the tool on the strip set vertically. You will need 2 cut with words **UP** and 2 words with words **DOWN**.

Cut 2 of the *full* tool shape. Cut 2 of the *reverse full* tool shape.




Align the Partial 1 slots of the tool to the edge of the strip.

The words on the tool are **UP**. Cut 10 of the *partial 1* tool shape.

Align the Partial 1 slots of the tool to the edge of the strip.

The words on the tool are **DOWN**.

Cut 10 of the *reverse partial 1* tool shape.



Align the Partial 2 slots of the tool to the edge of the strip.

The words on the tool are **UP**. Cut 10 of the *partial* **2** tool shape.

Align the Partial 2 slots of the tool to the edge of the strip.

The words on the tool are **DOWN**.

Cut 10 of the *reverse partial 2* tool shape.


Making Quads

Arrange and sew your squedge pieces to make each quad.


- reverse partial 2 -- 15°





Making Half Quads (right)




Making Half Quads (left)


Arrange and sew your squedge pieces to make triangles.



Add one corner tiangle to each quad and triangle.








Trim excess corner fabric using the Squedge Corner tool.




Add appliques if desired.

Assemble together into the runner.

Add backing, quilt as desired and bind.



Make 2 blocks.



Set #1 11 ½" A

Align **Vertically** Squedge 30

Cut 8 full squedges

Set #2

7 ³/₄" B

Align **Partial 1 line** words facing **UP**

Cut 10 partial 1 squedges

Set #3

7 ½" C

Align **Partial 2 line** words facing **UP**

Cut 10 partial 2 squedges

Set #1

11 ½" A

Align Vertically Squedge 15

Cut 2 full squedges Cut 2 reverse full squedges Set #2

7 ³/₄" B

Align Partial 1 line words facing **DOWN**

Cut 10 reverse partial 1 squedges

Set #3

7 ½" C

Align Partial 2 line words facing **DOWN**

Cut 10 reverse partial 2 squedges

Appliqué (optional)

Trace the stars onto the paper side of fusible web.

Bond to the back side of the star fabric.

Cut out the stars along the marked line.

Remove the paper.

Hint: a straight pin scratched along the paper back will help with paper removal.

Bond to the A fabric piece. What is xx piece? the Squedge 30 piece? is this what you meant?

Actually I meant to full scale....just so when you put all four together they balance--like as if you had a fussy cut... if the stars are a bit off they might not look right. Or they could wait until the whole block was aseembled.
