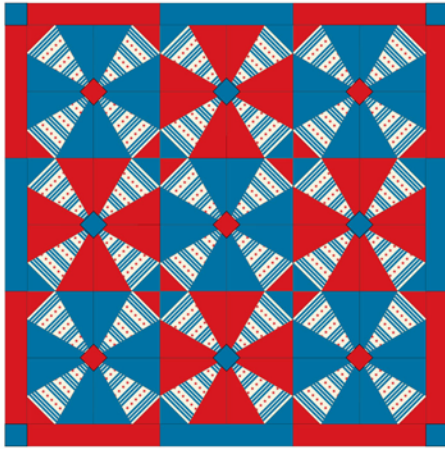


Stars and Stripes

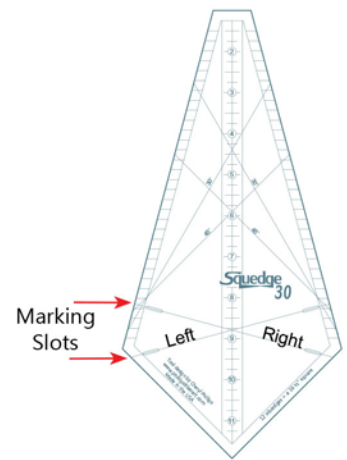

Fabric	Suggested Yardage	Cutting (full width)
A	1 5/8	four 7 3/4"
		four 3"
		four 2 1/2"
B	1 3/4 yards	three 7 3/4"
		four 3"
		four 2 1/2"
C	1 1/4 yd*	four 8 1/2"
batting	55" x 55"	
backing	57" x 57"	
binding	3/8 yd	six 2 1/2"

* allow more for stripe if needed



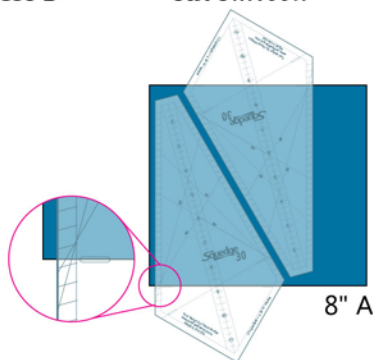
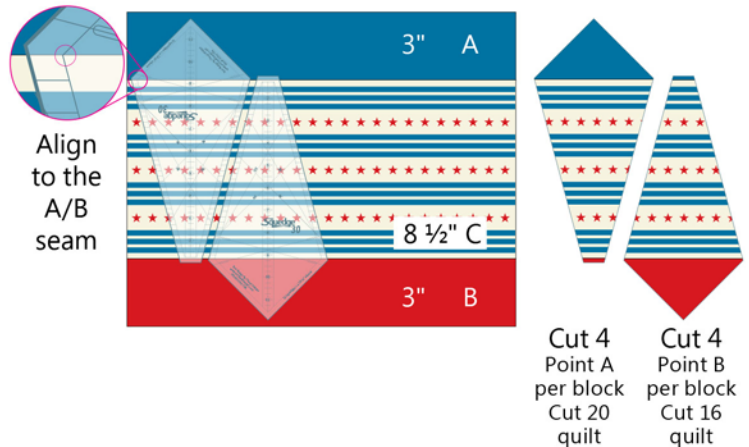
Apply adhesive non-slip rings to the back of the Squedge 30 tool.

- Cut strips as listed above.
- Sew strip set A-C-B.
- Align the bend of the 1/4" line printed on the tool to the A/B seam.
- Cut *twenty* Squedge 30s with the A fabric point and *sixteen* Squedge 30s with the E fabric point.
- Cut the following partial Squedge 30s with the *right* slotted line aligned to the edge of the fabric.

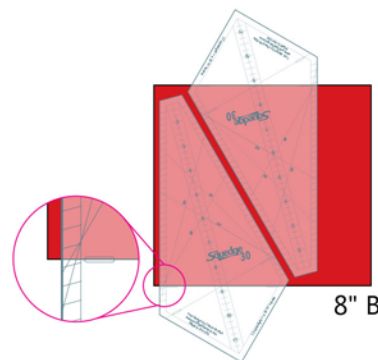
Fabric A cut *twenty*
Fabric B cut *sixteen*

- Cut the following partial Squedge 30s with the *left* slotted line aligned to the edge of the fabric. These pieces mirror image the ones cut earlier.

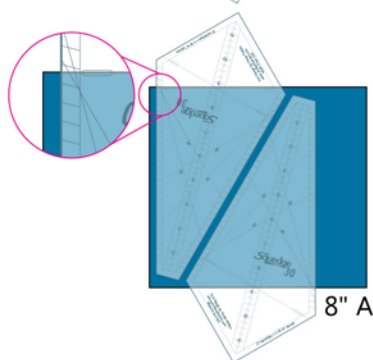
Fabric A cut *twenty*

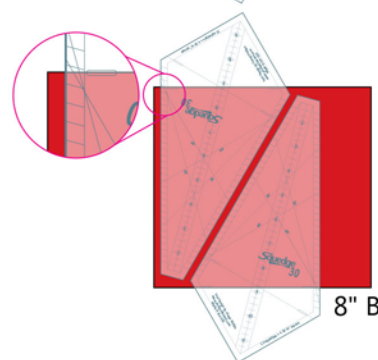

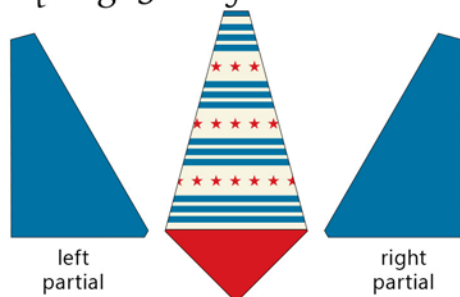

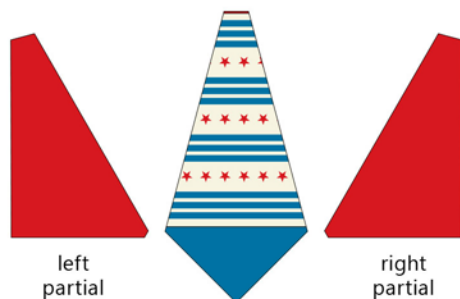

- Sub-cut border strips from the 2 1/2" wide Fabric A and B strips.

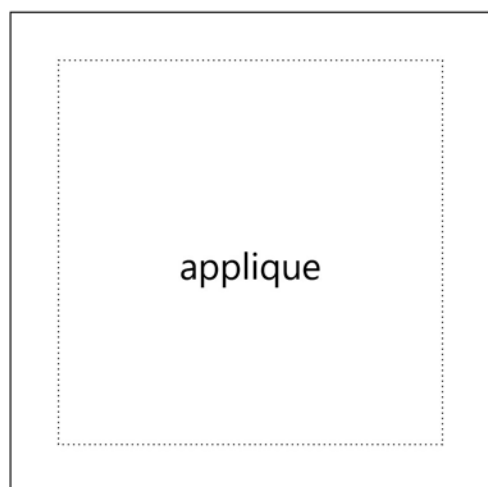

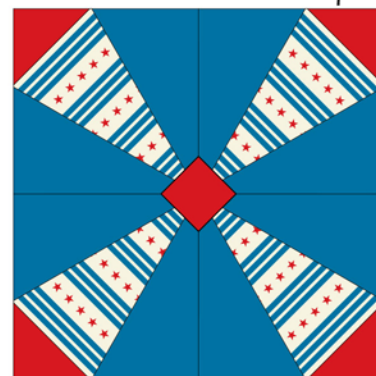

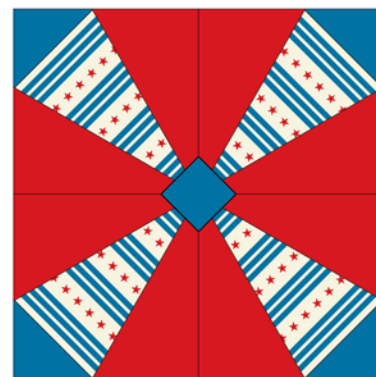


- Make *four* center appliques with Fabric A and *five* center appliques with Fabric B.
- Applique to the centers of the blocks as shown.

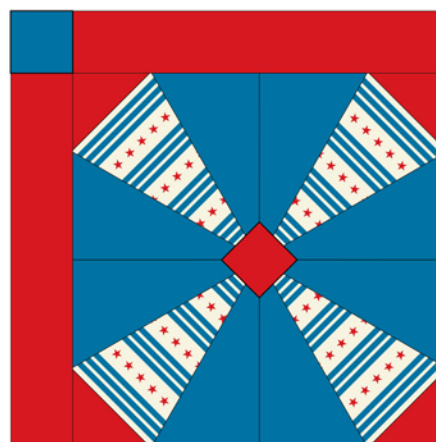
Star and Stripes



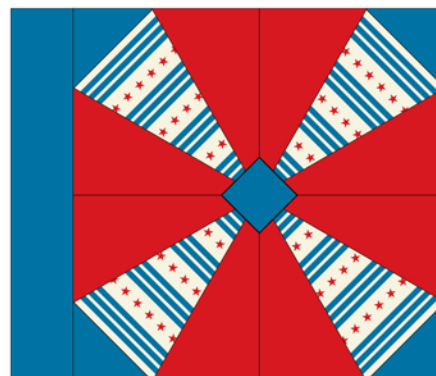
- Sew a right and left partial Squedge to a full Point E Squedge to make a quadrant.
- Sew four quadrants. Press.
- Sew the four quadrants together to make the center block. Press.
- Blocks show appliqued centers.



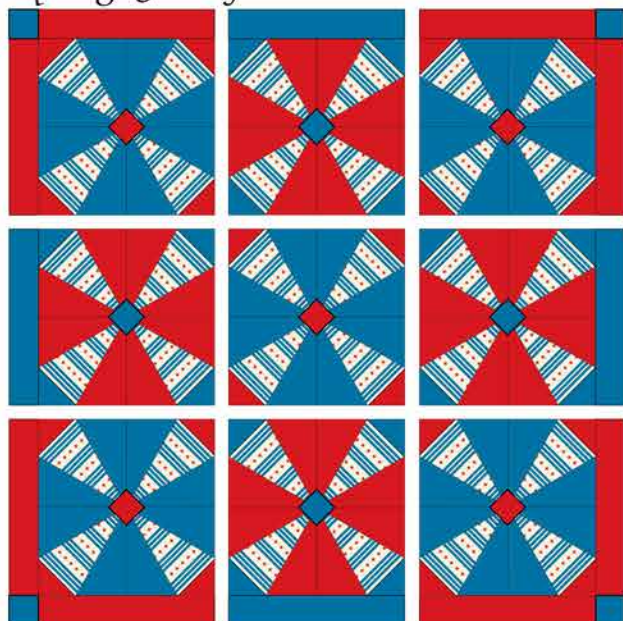
- Sew the Fabric B border strip to four Block A's.
- Set one Block A aside for the quilt center.
- Sew the A/B Border strip to the other side of Block A.
- Sew the Fabric A border strip to four Blocks B's.

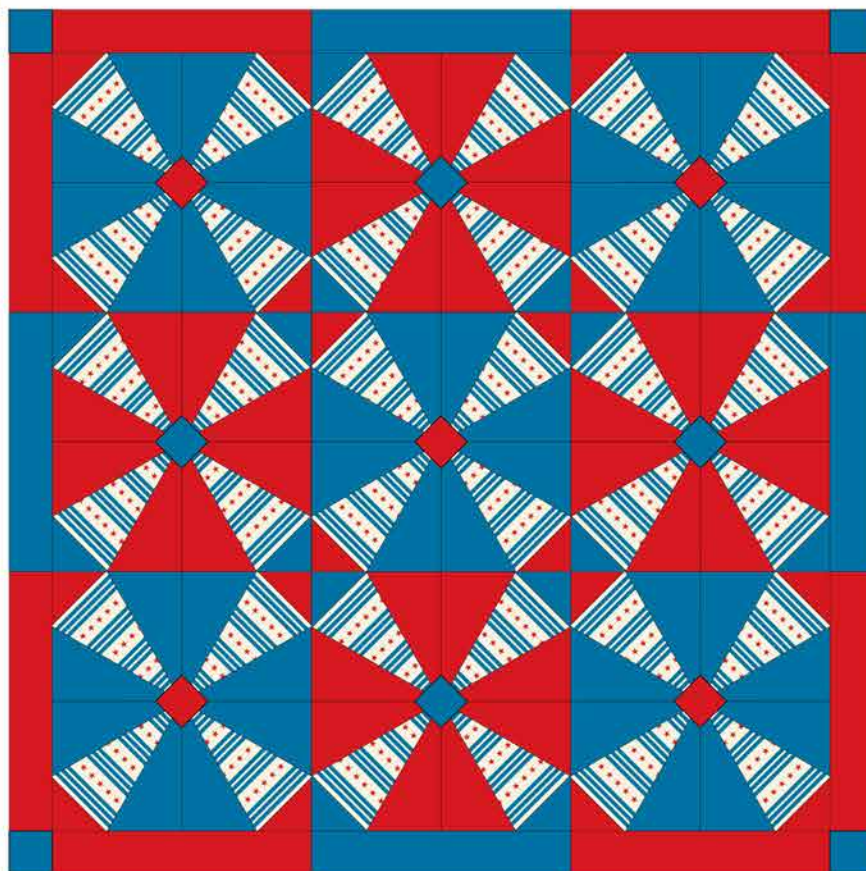

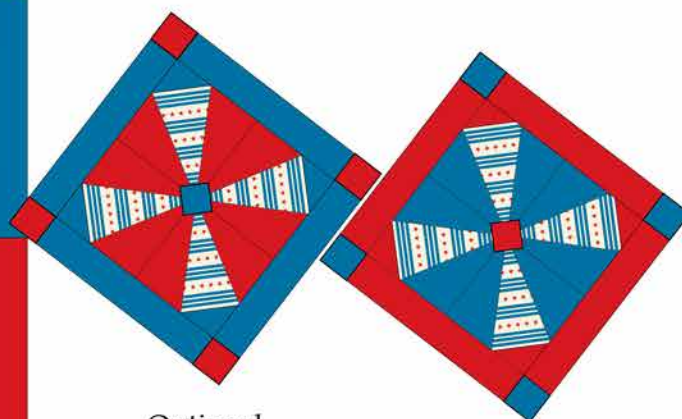
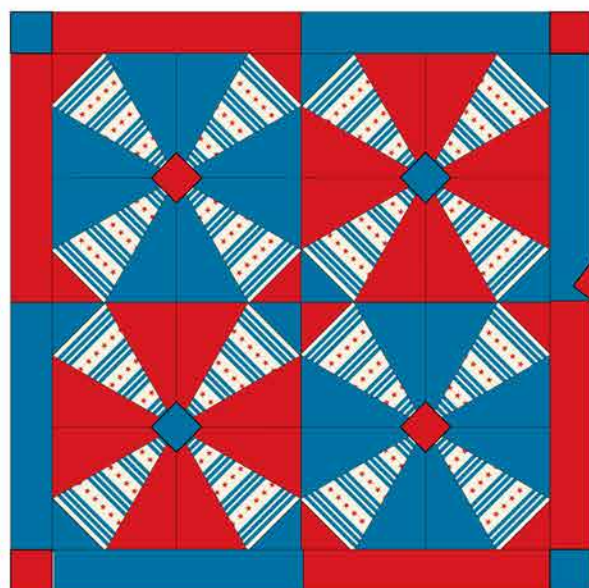
- Sew the blocks together as shown.
