

Ten Point Star

For the Ten Point Star you need either the standard Gem Ten or the Gem Junior tool.

Below is a list of the possible finished sizes:

Tool	Size	Project Size
Standard Gem Ten	Full	44" x 46"
Gem Junior	Junior	27" x 28"
	Petite	21 1/2" x 22 1/2"
	Mini	14" x 15"

Standard Size Tool		
	Yardage	Cutting
A	3/4 yd*	Two 11 1/2" x width of fabric**
B	3/4 yd	Two 11 1/2" x width of fabric
Border	1/2 yd	Ten 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" strips

* If you want to fussy cut a large print, you may need more fabric than suggested. Be sure you have 10 exact repeats. If you are making both points of the star the same as shown in the paisley sample, you will need 20 repeats of the same design.

** Cutting a strip is not needed when fussy cutting a particular design.

Smaller Sizes

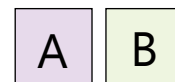
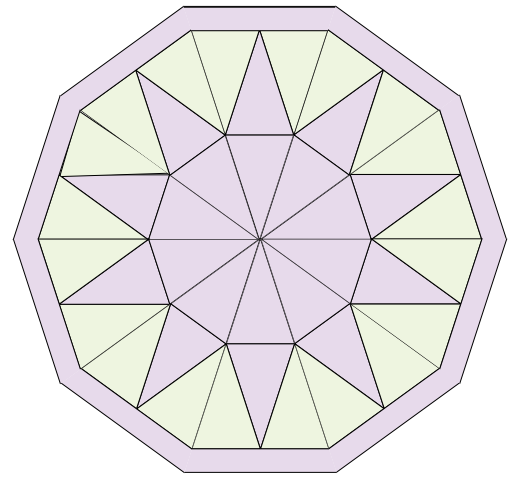
Junior Size Tool (Junior Size--uses full tool)		
	Yardage	Cutting
A	1/2 yd*	Two 6 3/4" x width of fabric**
B	1/2 yd	Two 6 3/4" x width of fabric
Border	1/4 yd	Ten 2" x 10 1/2" strips

Junior Size Tool (Petite Size--uses partial tool)		
	Yardage	Cutting
A	3/8 yd*	Two 5 1/2" x width of fabric**
B	3/8 yd	Two 5 1/2" x width of fabric
Border	1/4 yd	Ten 1 3/4" x 8 1/2" strips

Junior Size Tool (Mini Size--uses partial tool)		
	Yardage	Cutting
A	3/8 yd*	One 3 3/4" x width of fabric**
B	3/8 yd	One 3 3/4" x width of fabric
Border	1/8 yd	Ten 1 1/2" x 6" strips

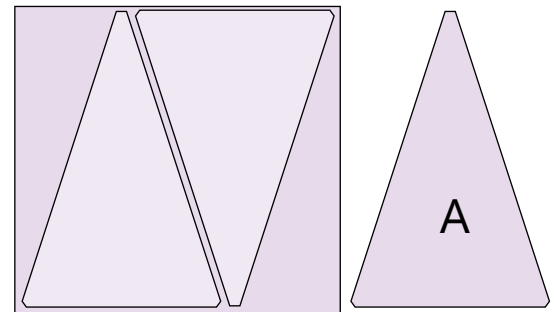
Tool Preparation

Prepare your Gem Ten tool by attaching either True Grips™ adhesive rings or loops of clear packaging tape to the tool.

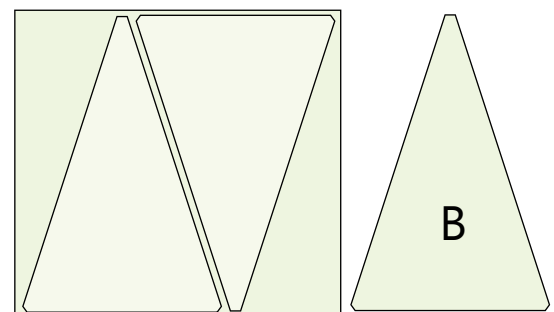


Cutting

- Cut strips as listed.
- Cut **twenty** of each A and B using your Gem Ten tool.



Cut 20

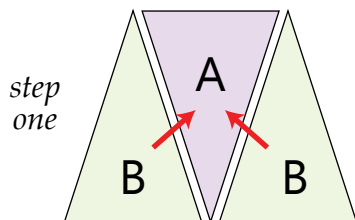


Cut 20

- If you're making the smaller sizes, cut pieces with the Gem Junior tool.
- Align the Petite and Mini lines to the edge of the strip.

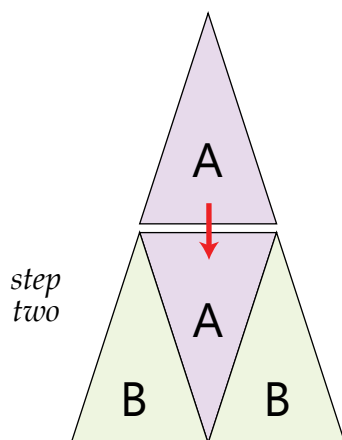
Triangles (step one)

- Sew a Gem Ten B to the center Gem Ten.
- Press toward the B fabric.
- Sew the other Gem Ten B piece to the center Gem Ten.
- Press toward the B fabric.



Triangles (step two)

- Add Gem Ten A.
- Press seams open.

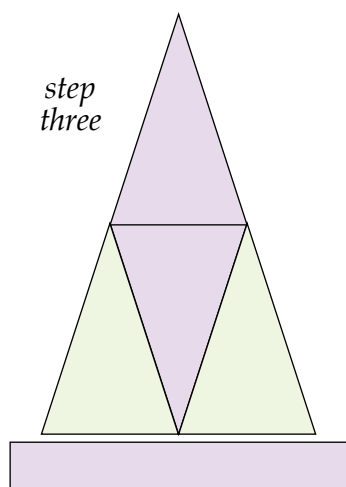


Triangles (step three)

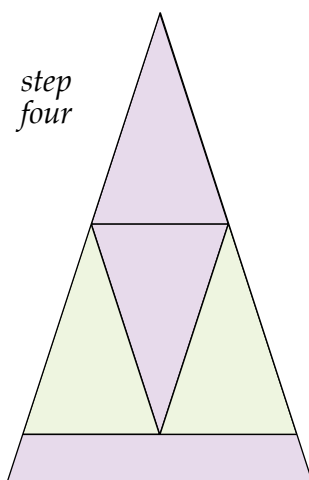
- Center the border strip.
- Sew the pieces together.
- Press the seams open or as desired.

Triangles (step four)

- Trim border to finish off the triangle.
- Repeat all Triangle steps for a total of **ten** triangles.

Trim border

Frame (optional)

- Add framer pieces to the units before assembling.
- Framing templates can be found on the inside of the tool packaging or ordered from Phillips Fiber Art (@ no charge).

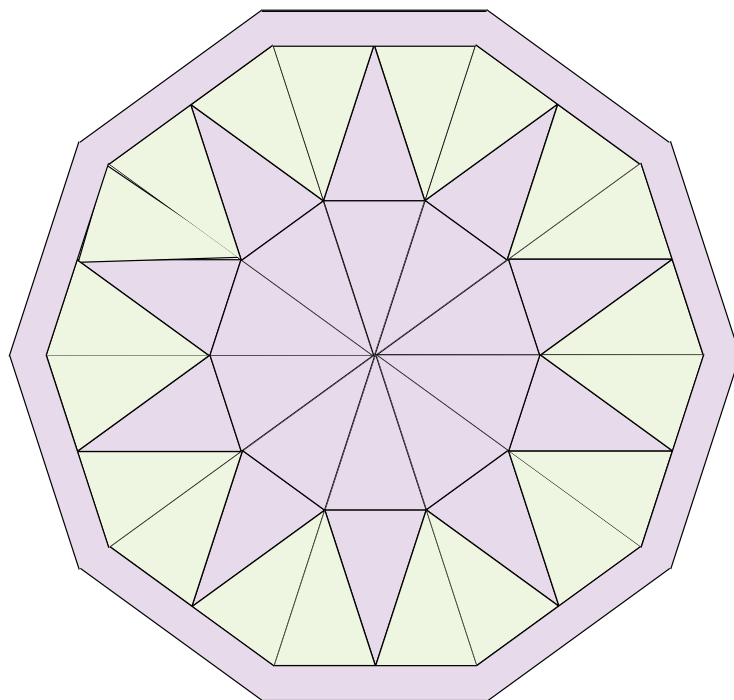
Assembly

- Sew the sections together in halves.
- Press seams open.
- Sew the halves together.
- Press.

Finish

- Layer
- Quilt
- Bind
