

Tilt A Whirl Variation

Be sure you have the basic instructions for the Tilt A Whirl pattern before proceeding with the Variation.

The Wedge

For this project we're using the large 15 degree wedge found in the Color Wheel Bargello pattern.

Tool Preparation

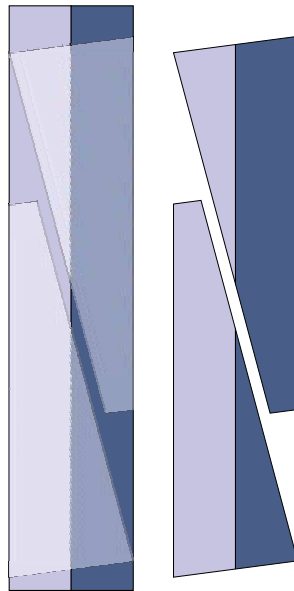
- Apply a long tube of wide transparent packaging tape, rolled with the sticky side out, to the back side of the wedge tool.

Center squares

- Cut 8" squares for the centers of your blocks or piece them as shown.

Left Wedges

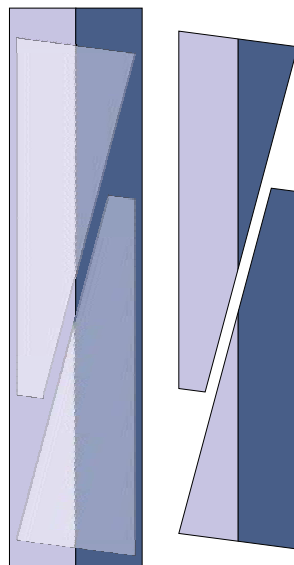
- Sew two 2 ¼" strips together. (eight strip sets)
- Align the wedge tool to the left side of the vertical strip set. Cut a wedge.
- Rotate the wedge and align the it to the right side of the strip set. Cut a second wedge.

Right Wedges

- Sew two 2 ¼" strips together. (eight strip sets)
- Align the wedge tool to the left side of the vertical strip set. Cut a wedge.
- Rotate the wedge and align the it to the right side

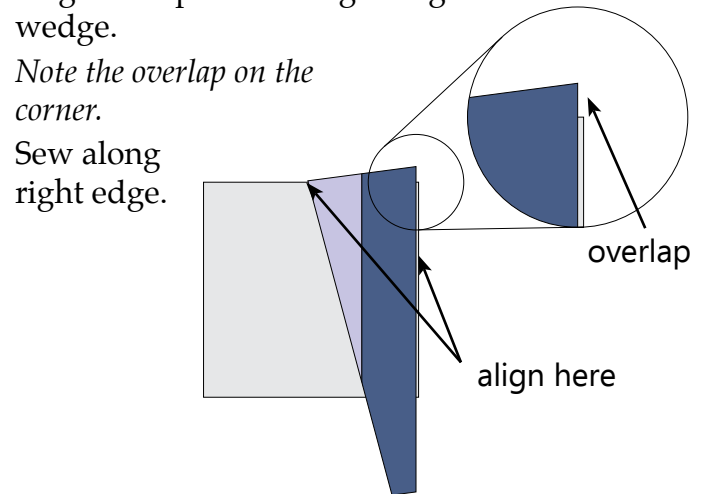
| Fabric | Exact amount | Suggested Yardage |
|-----------------------------|--------------|-------------------|
| A | 36" | 1 ¼ yds |
| B | 36" | 1 ¼ yds |
| C | 32" | 1 yd |
| Border | 24" | 1 yd* |
| Batting/ Backing | 60" x 60" | 2 yds |
| Binding | 24" | 1 yd |

All yardage is based on non-directional fabric.

Making Blocks

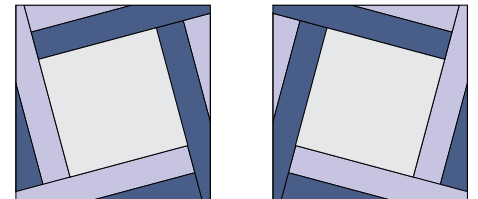
Follow all instructions found in the basic construction of the Tilt A Whirl pattern.

- Align the tip and the right edge of the wedge.
- Sew along right edge.



Making Blocks

Use left wedges to make left tilting blocks and right wedges to make right tilting blocks.



Each block uses both wedges made from the strip set.
