

# Rustic Wood Candles

Simple 4x4 wood posts are cut, drilled, and tied with twine to become rustic candles to warm up those cold winter evenings.

## WHAT YOU NEED FOR CANDLES

- 4x4-inch wood post (available at home stores)
- Table saw
- Sandpaper
- 1 1/2-inch spade bit (wide enough to accommodate the tea candle)
- Narrow twine
- Copper beads
- Tea candles

## HOW TO MAKE THE CANDLES

- 1 Cut the 4x4-inch post into desired heights. Sand any rough edges.
- 2 Drill a hole, about 1/2-inch deep in the top center of each cut piece. Make the hole deep enough to accommodate the tea candle.
- 3 Wrap each wood section with twine, wrapping as many times around as desired. String one or more copper beads through the twine and tie to secure.
- 4 Place candle in the drilled hole at the top.

**Never leave a burning candle unattended.**
