Please read all instructions before starting. Measurement on borders are approximate. Measure your quilt top before cutting.
Use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

Cutting Instructions:

Background

- Cut one 9 1/2" square;
- Cut two 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips;
- Cut two 2 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips.

Inner Border & Flowers

- Cut two 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips;
- Cut two 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips;
- See instructions to cut four flowers and centers.

Outer Border

- Cut two 3" x 20 1/2" strips;
- Cut two 3" x 15 1/2" strips.

Bunny

- See instructions to cut one Bunny.

Ears, Nose and Flowers

- See instructions to cut the inner ears, nose and four flowers and centers.

Eyes

- See instructions to cut the eyes.

Eyes & Teeth

- See instructions to the eyes and teeth.

Flowers & Centers

- See instructions to cut four flowers and centers.

Flowers & Centers

- See instructions to cut four flowers and centers.

Leaves & Stems

- See instructions to cut the leaves and stems;
- Cut three 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips for the binding.

Grass, Carrot Tops & Binding

- See instructions to cut the grass and carrot tops.

Carrots

- See instructions to cut the carrots.

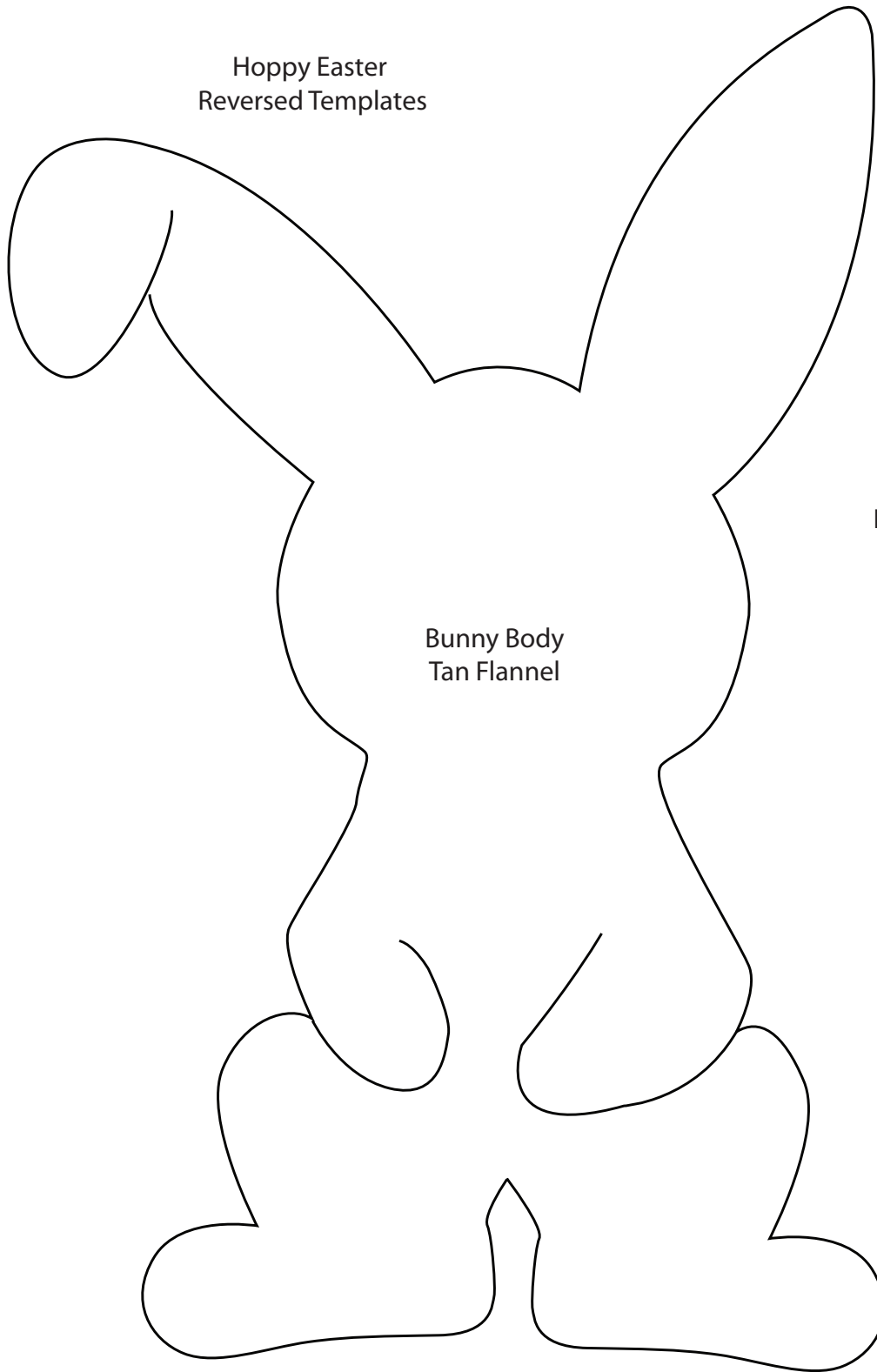


Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

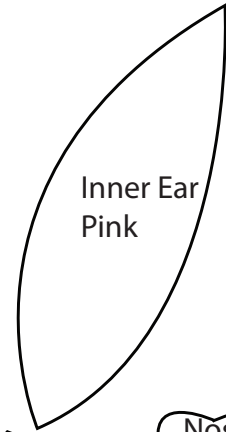
1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape outside of the drawn lines. Press each shape to the back side of the fabric as listed on the templates. Cut out each shape on the drawn lines.
2. Refer to the placement drawing to assemble the Bunny, grass and three flowers on the 9 ½" square.
OPTIONAL: Use an applique pressing sheet over the placement drawing and assemble the bunny and flowers on the pressing sheet first. Press the grass onto the background. Press the bunny and flowers onto the 9-1/2" background square. Finish the edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch to complete the background center.
3. Sew one 1 ½" x 9 ½" purple strip to each side of the background center. Sew one 1 ½" x 11 ½" purple strip to the top and bottom of the background center.
4. Sew one 2 ½" x 11 ½" blue strip to each side of the background center. Sew one 2 ½" x 15 ½" blue strip to the top and bottom of the background center.
5. Sew one 3" x 15 ½" jelly beans strip to each side of the background center. Sew one 3" x 20 ½" jelly beans strip to the top and bottom of the background center.
6. Assemble eight flowers and eight carrots onto the 2 ½" blue border as desired or following our quilt photo. Press in place. Finish the raw edges with a decorative stitch.
7. Layer and quilt as desired
8. Sew the three 2 ½" x 42" light green strips together end-to-end with 45° seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
9. Bind as desired.

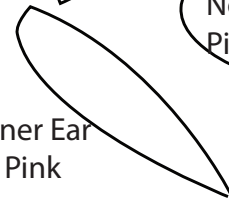

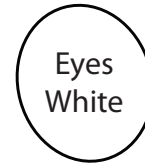

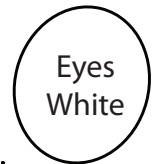

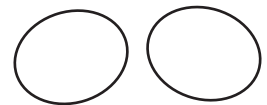

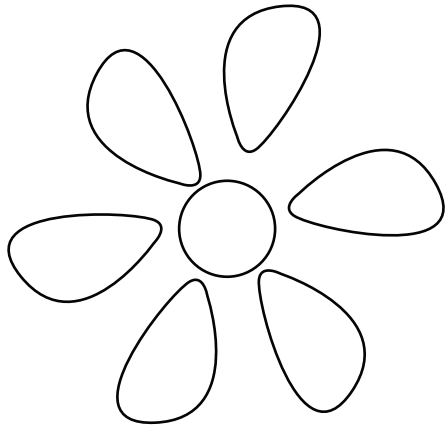

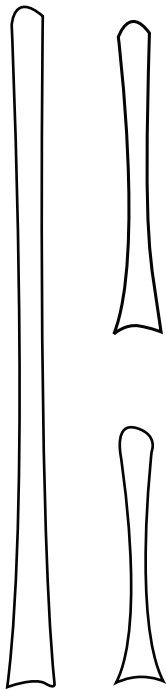

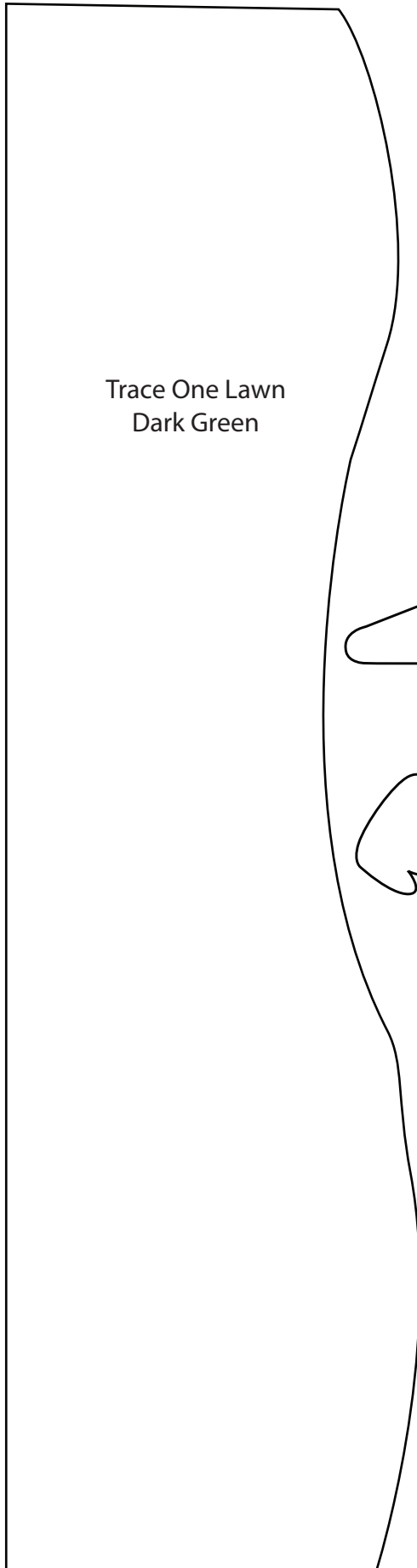
*Trace Twelve Flowers & centers

Four Yellow



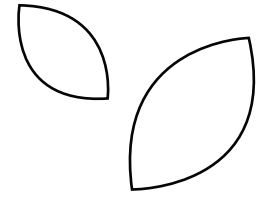
Trace one Large and
