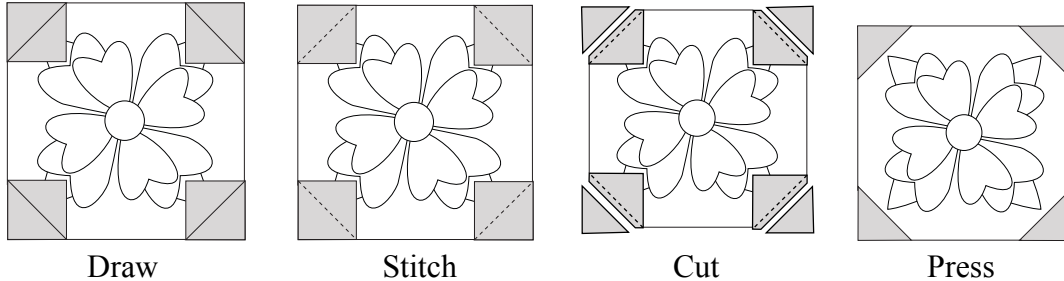


96 - 1 1/2" squares. Draw one diagonal on the wrong side of each square.

Appliqué:

Using your favorite appliqué method, appliqué the floral design on to the center of the 8 1/2" blocks. Remember this is a scrap quilt so try to use as many different fabrics as possible. When done, lightly steam each block (from the back) then trim to 6 1/2" square. When done you will have 24 appliqued 6 1/2" squares.

Place one of the 1 1/2" squares in each corner of an appliqued square. Stitch directly on the drawn line. Trim away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press open.



From your scraps and stash make the following half-square triangle units. One method of preparing these units is given, however, there are many methods of making half-square triangles. Please feel free to use your favorite method.

Half-square Triangles: (We will make these oversized then trim to the correct size.)

To make 2 half-square triangles cut the following:

- 1 – 2 7/8" square of cream colored fabric
- 1 – 2 7/8" square of a medium to dark print

Mark a diagonal on the wrong side of the cream colored fabric.

Place the cream colored square and the print square on top of each other, right sides together.

Stitch a scant 1/4" on either side of the drawn diagonal, stitching through both layers of fabric.

Cut on diagonal. Open each and press. 2 half-square triangle units have been made. Repeat 239 times to make a total of 480 half-square triangle units.

Trim the half-squares to 2" square.
