### Special tools required:

Sewing machine with zig zag capabilities

Open toe foot

Teflon press sheet or parchment paper

Wonder clips or similar for binding



### Fabric Needed:

- 1 – 11" x 9" fabric for background
- 1 – 11" x 9" fabric for backing
- 1 – 11" x 9" Fusible fleece or batting

### Fabric Needed for Applique:

- 1 - 5" square yellow fabric for sun & lights in lighthouse
- 1 - 2" x 5" rectangle fabric for boat
- 2 - 4" x 5" rectangle fabric for sails
- 1 - 1" x 4" rectangle fabric for mast
- 1 - 3" x 7" rectangle fabric white for lighthouse
- 1 - 4' x 6" rectangle fabric white for cloud, portals & lighthouse windows
- 1 - 3" x 7" rectangle red fabric for lighthouse stripes.
- 2 – 12" pieces of rick rack
- 1 - 2 ½" x 42" WOF for binding
- 2 - 8 ½" x 11" Heat 'n Bond or similar paper-backed fusible web

Matching or contrasting thread. Optional: gold metallic for the sun, lighthouse lights & top of mast



**Before Class Preparation:** Printout template from <https://so-sew-easy.com/nautical-mug-rug> and trace template onto paper side of paperbacked fusible web.

Bonus Scrappy Stars Mug Rug: Bring red & white 1 ½" fabric strips, multiple lengths 12" or shorter. 1 each 5" x 7" rectangle fabric for backing, background & batting.

**Basic Tools:**

90/14 quilting needle & 90/14 metallic or top stitch needle

A sewing machine in good working order with foot pedal, cord, thread, bobbin and needles

Pins, small scissors for trimming threads, seam ripper (if needed)

Cutting mat, rotary cutter (45 or 60mm), ruler(s)

Your own portable iron and pad; there will also be one or two set up in room.
