



Class Description:

Using simple 9-patch block to teach chain-piecing & sewing with accuracy. Take the 9-patch and cut it creating a new block & exploring new design options. Learn about borders: why we use, increase size or add design. Discuss types of borders: single fabric, pieced, with cornerstones or mitered. Learn to measure borders as the next step in keeping the quilt square. Class goal with quilt: several rows of the new design pieced.
