

**Class Description:** Couching is a form of embellishment done on the top of a fabric with yarn, cording or ribbon. This material is laid out on top of the fabric it needs to be attached to and then sewn down with either a straight stitch or a zigzag stitch.

After a short discussion on techniques, class participants will start on one of two projects or a sampler of techniques. There will be enough time given to complete one of the projects.
