The WW II Memorial in Washington, DC was built to honor the 16 million Americans who served during World War II. The Honor Flight Network is a national network of non-profit organizations dedicated to transporting as many U.S. Military veterans as possible to see the memorials at no cost to the veterans.

The Villages Honor Flight is the local chapter and has served 1,032 veterans to date. As part of this special event, each veteran receives a special quilt as a gift to use that day. The 58"x72" quilt is another part of the memories they have from that trip. Each quilt has a label which states "Thank you for your Service" with the name of the Chapter donating the quilt and the date.
