

Class Description: This is your chance to unearth the wedge ruler* that's been gathering dust in your sewing room, and learn how to use it to make a wedge quilt. Using only three fabrics, students will cut and use 9° or 10° fabric wedges to make a 33" X 33" "Carousel" quilt that can be used as a wall hanging or table topper. When you've learned the fundamentals of sewing wedges, you'll begin to see possibilities for more designs. This workshop was inspired by Christina Cameli's book Modern Wedge Workshop, and the "Carousel" quilt is an original design by Linda. *If you don't have a wedge ruler, a template will be provided that can be affixed to a 6" X 12" ruler.

member of Big Cypress Quilters, Linda moved from Iowa where previous jobs included editor of *American Patchwork and Quilting* magazine, and freelance writing for Fons & Porter *Love of Quilting*, among other quilting publications.
