Class Description: This is your chance to unearth the wedge ruler* that's been gathering dust in your sewing room, and learn how to use it to make a wedge quilt. Using only three fabrics, students will cut and use 9° or 10° fabric wedges to make a 33" X 33" "Carousel" quilt that can be used as a wall hanging or table topper. When you've learned the fundamentals of sewing wedges, you'll begin to see possibilities for more designs. This workshop was inspired by Christina Cameli's book *Modern Wedge Workshop*, and the "Carousel" quilt is an original design by Linda. *If you don't have a wedge ruler, a template will be provided that can be affixed to a 6" X 12" ruler.

About the Instructor: A member of Big Cypress Quilters, Linda moved from Iowa where previous jobs included editor of *American Patchwork and Quilting* magazine, and freelance writing for Fons & Porter *Love of Quilting*, among other quilting publications. She published the book *First Time Quiltmaking* in 2009. She continues to teach, focusing on free motion quilting and ruler quilting on a home sewing machine.
