It's the return of Pillowcase Pandemonium! On the first Tuesday of the month, September 3rd, we will be sewing up pillowcases for children. Please bring two coordinating yards of appropriate novelty fabric to make two pillowcases (27" for the body + 9" for the cuff). If you have 2"-3" strips to use as the accent stripe, that really looks cute.

The committee has a few kits made up from donated fabric, as well as a stack of cuff and accent fabric to pair with your yardage.

Please bring your sewing machine with neutral thread, all the other supplies you need, a rotary cutter and long rulers to square up & trim. We will be using the usual "hot dog" method of pillowcase construction, with French (enclosed) seams and the accent strip.

As always you are welcome to work on your own charity project on September 3rd instead of the pillowcases if you prefer. The charity fabric bin has a lot of 2-1/2" strips and some 10" squares just waiting to be sewn into a hug. Please let someone on the Charity Committee know what you need.

Our blue & white and red & white half square triangles have been sewn into quilt tops and look terrific!! Thank you to the designers and sewers who have transformed a pile of scraps into something lovely and had fun doing it! Sheila is quilting the blue & white top; the red & white top is available if you would like to transform it into a quilt.

Please plan to finish up your Guardian Ad Litem quilts by the end of November, as we will be presenting them before the holidays. We also hope to deliver another batch of placemats to Operation Homebound by the end of the year so they can be included in our yearly charity tracking report.

We hope the Lake Miona quilters who are somewhere else this summer are enjoying some sewing time and are able to make a couple pillowcases, placemats, or a quilt for the Guardian Ad Litem program. We look forward to your return!

## CREATIVE QUILTERS MARKET COMING OCTOBER 5, 2019 @ SAVANNAH CENTER

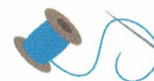

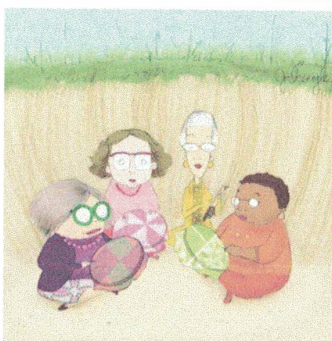

Please take this opportunity to get your creative juices flowing & participate in this fun event.

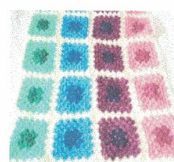
