

The Utah Quilt Guild (UQG) is a non-profit organization formed in 1977 to encourage, promote and preserve the art of quilt making in Utah.

To achieve these goals, the UQG fosters an appreciation of all quilts. We sponsor and support quilt shows, teach quilt making skills and seek out ways to preserve the history of Utah quilting and quilt makers.

The UQG is organized into geographic areas and the areas into chartered chapters.

Newcomers are welcome at open chapter meetings. Meeting places and times are available on the UQG website, periodically listed in the *Beeline*, and also from the area representatives which are listed inside this brochure.

Membership in the UQG is open to anyone interested in quilts and quilt making. Annual membership dues are \$20.00.

The benefits of membership include:

- Subscription to the *Beeline* newsletter (which is online)
- Discounted entrance and workshop fees at UQG sponsored events, including Quilt Fest, our annual retreat and workshop
- Discounts at many local UQG sponsoring quilt stores
- Access to on-line resources, such as local teachers list, and local quilting store guide
- Opportunity to interact with almost a thousand dedicated quilters in Utah and across the country!

The *Beeline*, published eleven times a year, is our primary communication tool and regularly includes area and chapter activities, articles about and by local quilters, dates and times for upcoming quilt shows, contests, patterns, tips and reviews. It is also where contests and information about special UQG discounts are announced.

Our annual "Quilt Festival" or Quilt Fest is open to everyone with special discounts for UQG members. This event, held each fall, includes a judged quilt show, workshops with national and local teachers, along with a merchant's mall. In addition, the UQG sponsors and supports other quilt shows, workshops and lectures during the year throughout the state.

As a non-profit organization, the UQG and its chapters are involved in many different community service projects. Some of our service projects placed quilts in police cars for use when assisting abused children; delivered quilts to children's hospitals; and, provided quilts and monetary support to wounded warriors and veterans.

Quilters are a special breed of talented and generous people. Our members willingly share their time, supplies and talents both to serve others and encourage newcomers to the art and joy of quilt making. Come join us and celebrate the many diverse aspects of quilting in Utah!
