

## **Really Mini Redbird and Berries Wool Applique w/ FMQ McTavishing**

### **Supplies:**

- Size 5 Crewel/embroidery needle (Bohin is my favorite)
- Serrated edge scissors – small (4” Elan or Karen K Buckley Perfect Scissors)
- Applique pins or small stapler for basting (Roxanne Glue-Baste-It or basting thread works too)
- Water or air soluble marking pen – Dritz Dual Purpose marking pen is a great choice
- Small iron and pressing board - June Taylor Cut-n-Press is a great notion to have for wool work
- 15” x 17” backing fabric, binding, and batting (100% wool batting recommended) will be required to finish the project

### **Notes:**

- Pattern, including applique shapes printed on Freezer paper will be provided
- “McTavishing” can be practiced on paper with pencil – OR – bring your machine setup for free motion quilting to practice on a machine.
- Aurifil Cotton 50wt/2ply is best for McTavishing.
