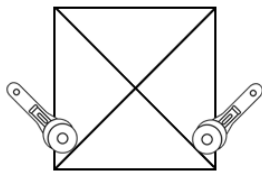
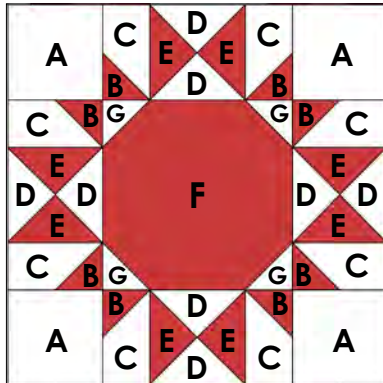


Cutting

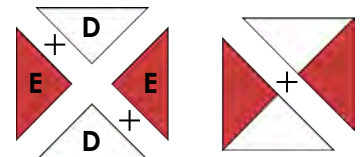


Cut Square Twice
Diagonally

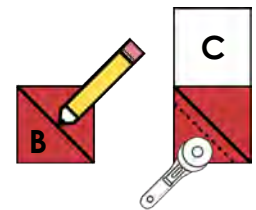
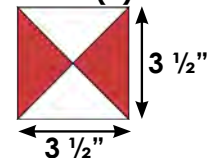
A	(4) 3 1/2" squares.
B	(8) 2" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.
C	(8) 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.
D	(2) 4 1/4" squares; cut each square twice diagonally to make (8) D triangles.
E	(2) 4 1/4" squares; cut each square twice diagonally to make (8) E triangles.
F	(1) 6 1/2" square.
G	(4) 2" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.

Assembly

1. Begin block assembly by making QST units. Place (2) D triangles and (2) E triangles together as shown. The longest edges of the triangles will create the edges of the QST unit.
2. Sew together as shown, pressing toward the dark fabric.
3. Repeat to make (4) identical QST units measuring 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished.
4. Continue block assembly by making stitch and flip units. Place (1) B square with a drawn diagonal line onto the bottom corner of (1) C rectangle, right sides together and edges aligned. Diagrams show accurate B square placement.
5. Sew along the drawn diagonal line. Trim outermost excess fabric to 1/4" and press to the corner.
6. Repeat to make (4) identical stitch and flip units in which the B square is placed on the bottom left corner, and (4) mirror image stitch and flip units in which the B square is placed on the bottom right corner. All stitch and flip units created in this step should measure 2" x 3 1/2" unfinished.

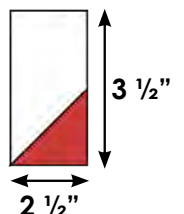

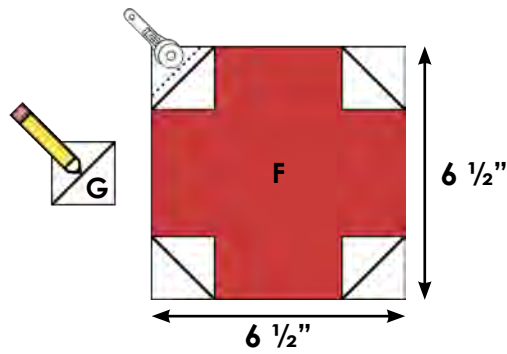

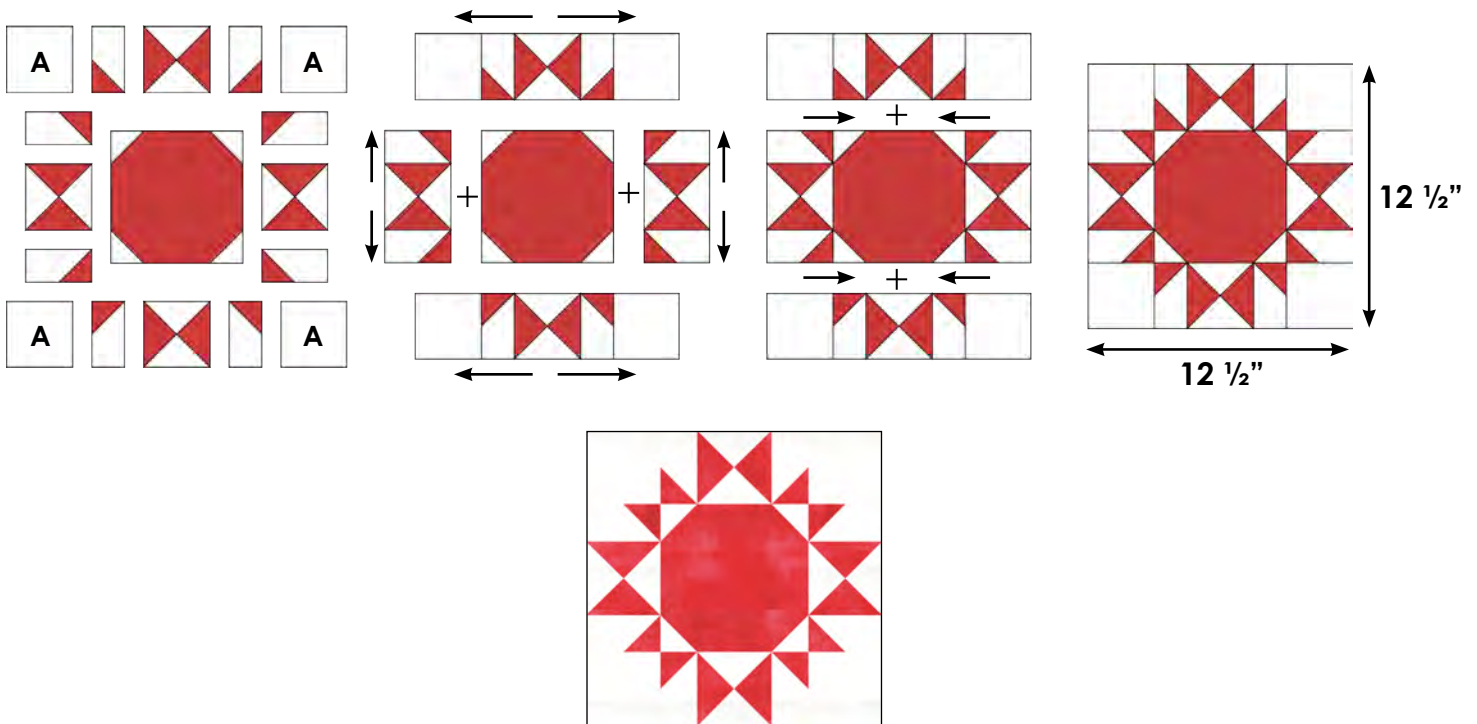

- Using stitch and flip techniques described above, attach (4) G squares to all corners of (1) F square as shown to make the block center. Press outward. Stitch and flip unit created in this step should measure $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished.



- Lay out all stitch and flip units created in Steps 4-6, the block center, (4) QST units and (4) A squares as shown. Please note the orientation and placement of the stitch and flip units.
- Once you have confirmed all units are placed correctly, sew together as shown in the diagram. Arrows indicate pressing instructions.
- Sew block together to complete. Press. Completed block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished.
