### Requirements:

.3m spikes sub-cut: 9 or more -4"X8" cuddle for spikes

.3m monster body

Poly-fil

## MONSTER TAIL KIDS TRAVEL PILLOW

A TRIED&TRUE FREE PATTERN

1. The spike are slightly filled with [Fairfield Poly-Fil](#) before being sewn (inward facing) on one panel of the body.
2. Sew both body panels (right sides facing) together using a 1/4" seam and leaving a 5" section open to turn right side out. Take care not to accidentally sew any of the spikes!
3. Now just fill the body tightly with [Fairfield Poly-Fil](#) and hand sew the opening shut. Roar! (that's monster talk for "Yay!")

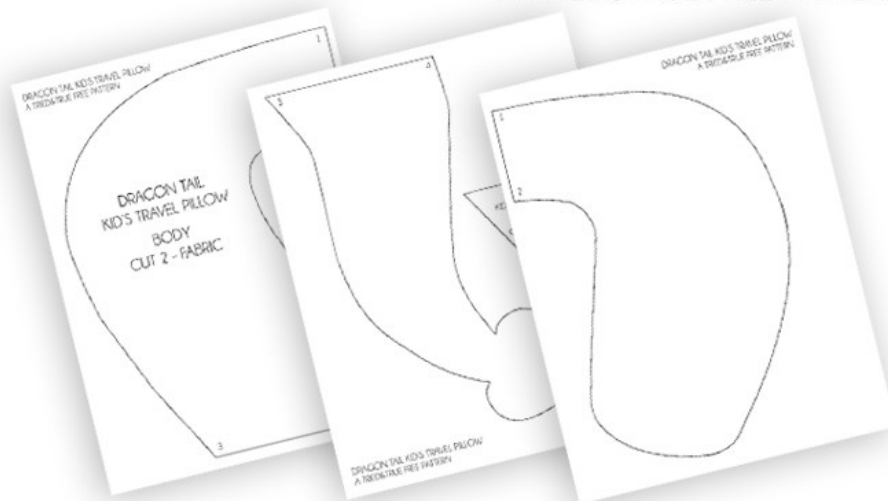
### READY FOR THE ROAD

This Monster Tail Kid's Travel Pillow is perfectly sized for small children (probably ages 2-10.) You can always enlarge the pattern a bit for older kids or shrink for smaller. The pattern comes as three printable sheets that you'll need to tape together by matching the numbers. Cut as many pair of spikes as you want, I made 9 but kinda wish I had more. *Please refrain from using for commercial purposes or Vanessa will have to send her sea monster after*

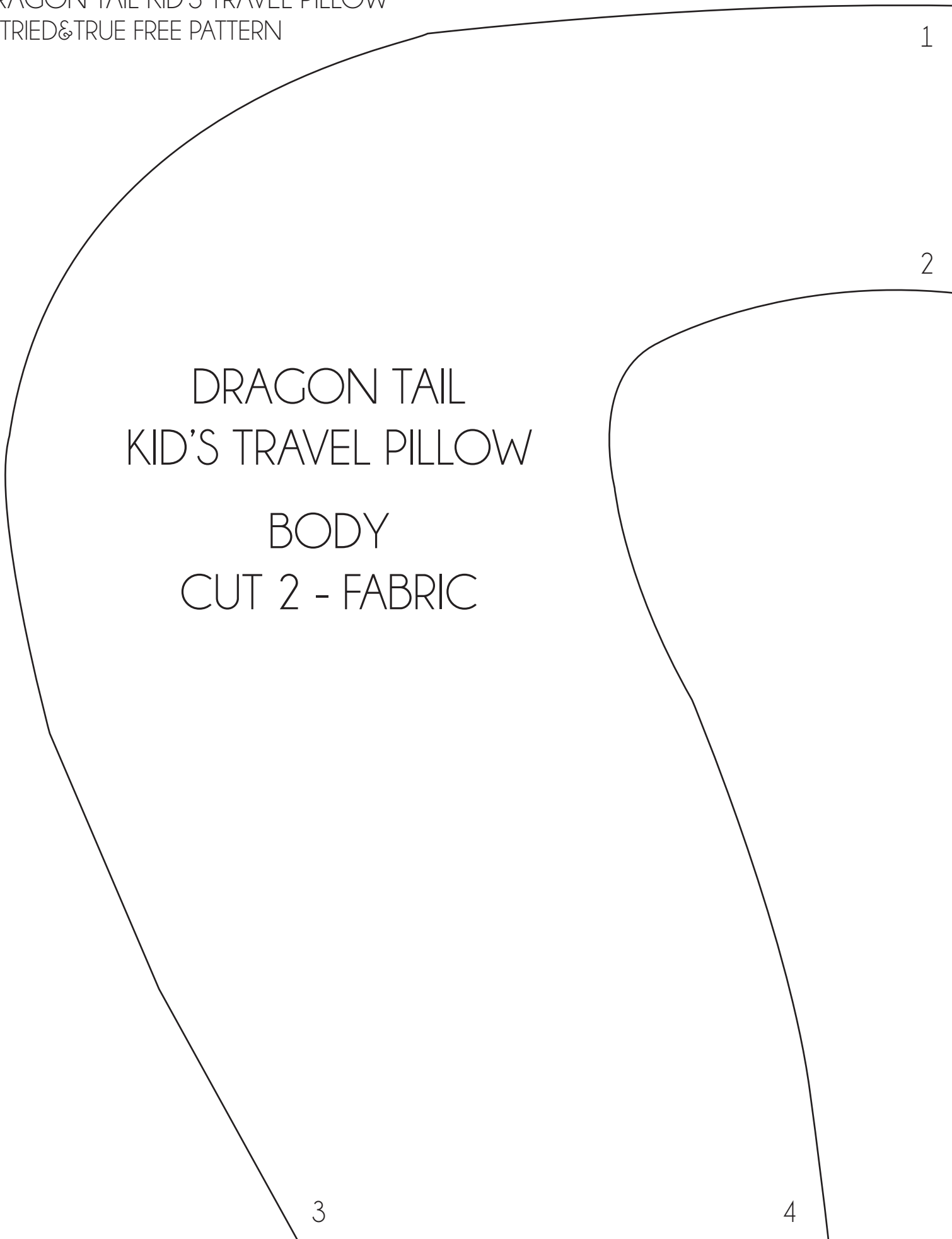

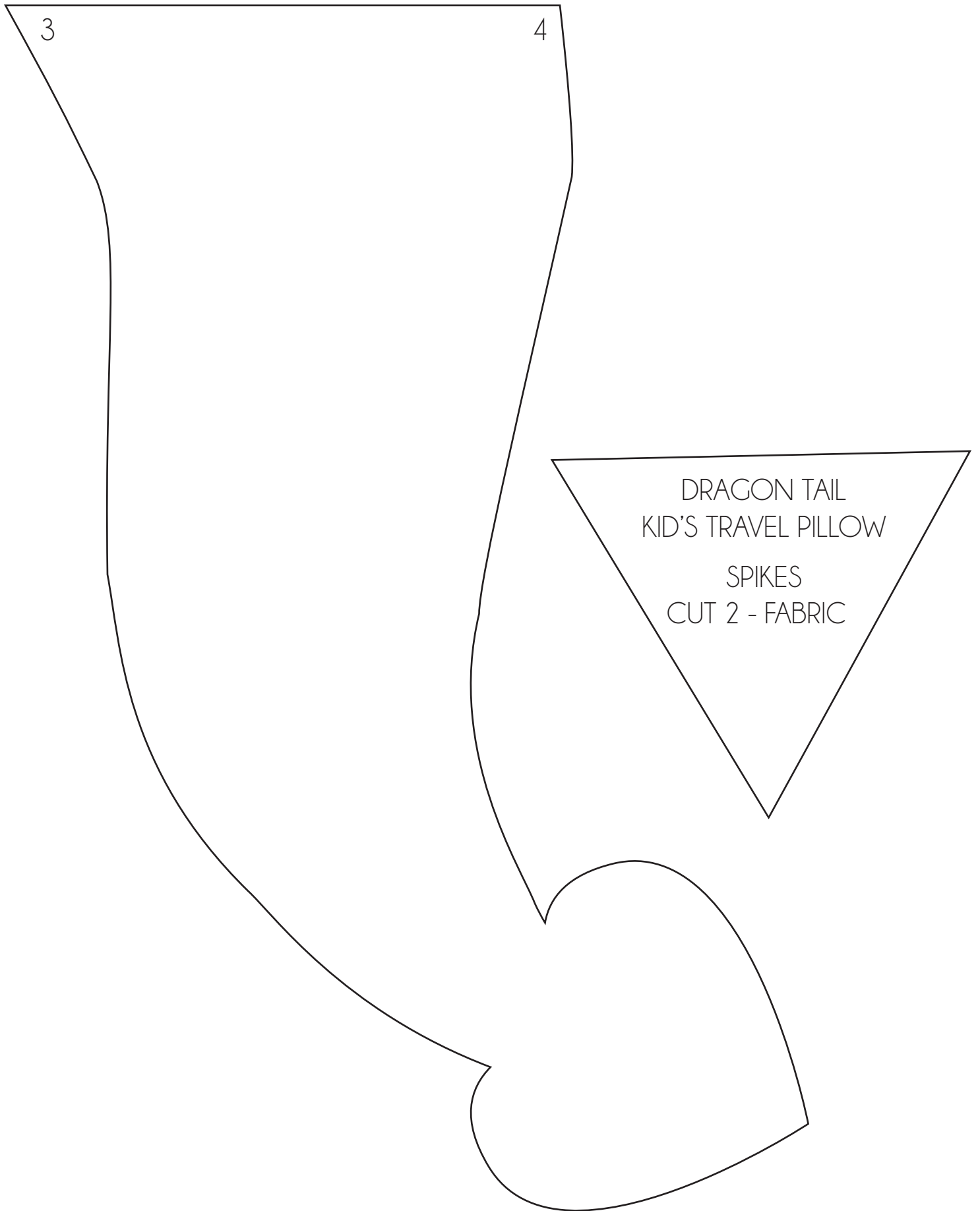
