
Kathy showed off her final finish for the year.

Paco had a Jelly Roll Race quilt as a PhD. She sewed the final two parts of the race and added borders.






She also made this quick Layer Cake On-Point quilt.





- Complete a registration form. Dueonor before Jan 10th 2024
- List the steps that you need to take to complete this project. Or If you have more than one of these projects, list the steps for each you want to work on.

<u>NOTE</u>: Projects should be already be 'in progress' in some form; cut out, part sewn, etc.
