Blocks will be made into quilts for the Grant County veterans by the Southwest Valor Quilters.
Cutting from yardage to make 3 Ohio Star Blocks at a time - wof = width of fabric Cut from Red fabric: 1 strip measuring $51 / 2 " x$ wof; 1 strip measuring $41 / 2$ " x wof, Cut from White fabric: 1 strip measuring $51 / 2 " x$ wof; 1 strips measuring 5 " x wof, Cut from Blue fabric: 1 strip measuring 5 " x wof.
