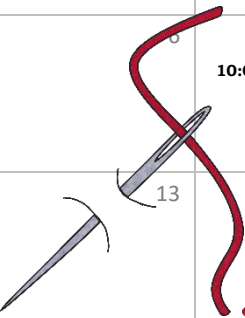

Dona and LeAnne tried their hand at fabric painting! They took a class and created these colorful Southwest desert scenes.

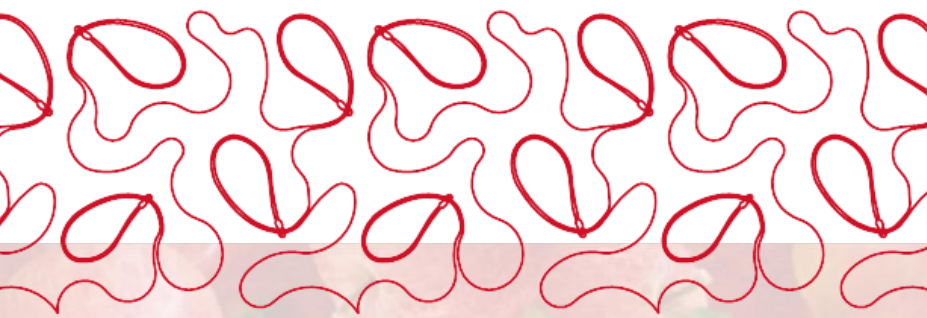

Sylvia made this colorful jelly roll strip quilt for her granddaughter's 14th birthday. What a fun gift to celebrate becoming another year older!

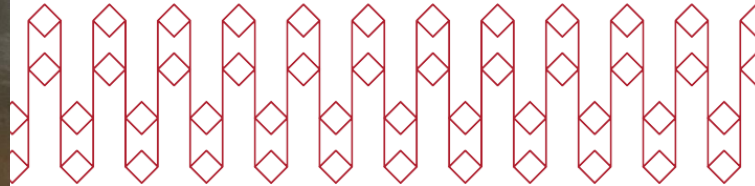

Cutting from yardage to make 8 Echoes Blocks at a time – *wof = width of fabric*

Cut from Print Fabric: 1 strip, measuring 5 ½" x wof,

Cut from **Red** or **Blue** fabric: 4 strips, measuring 3" x wof,

Cut from White fabric: 4 strips, measuring 3" x wof.
