We will be doing inventory on Dec 26th - 28th, then will be open Dec 29th & 30th for an inventory reduction sale, online and in store.

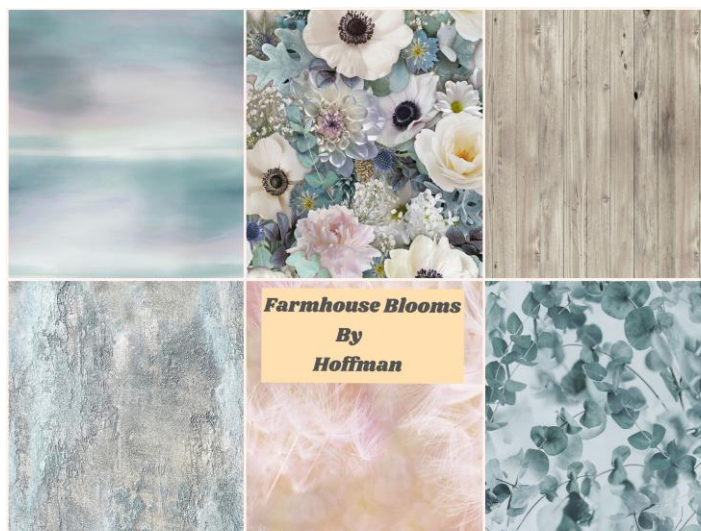
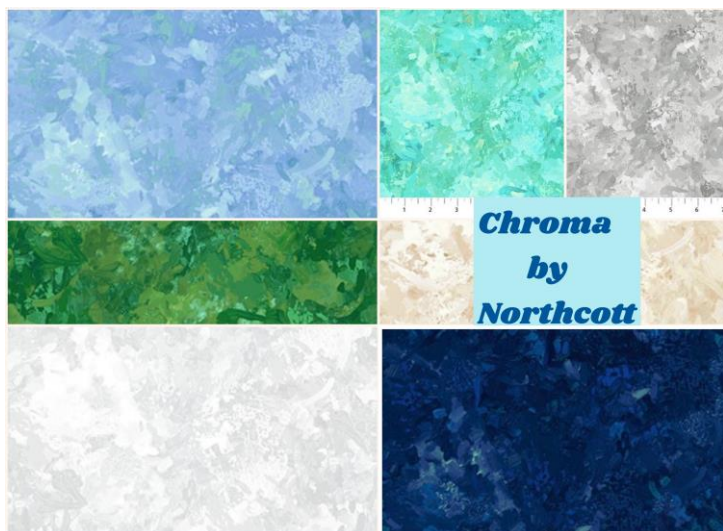
I hope you all have a spectacular Christmas and a safe and fun New Year.

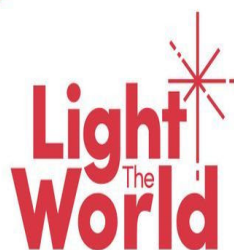


Christmas is coming...Ho ho ho

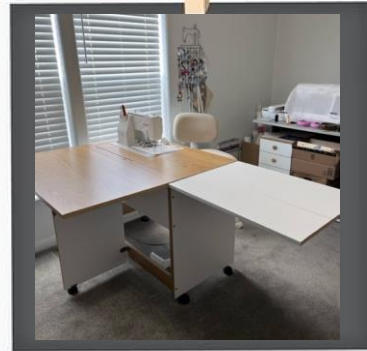

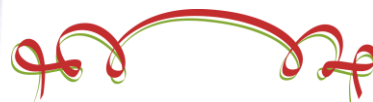
