Hope everyone has a great month, enjoy the warmer sunshine.

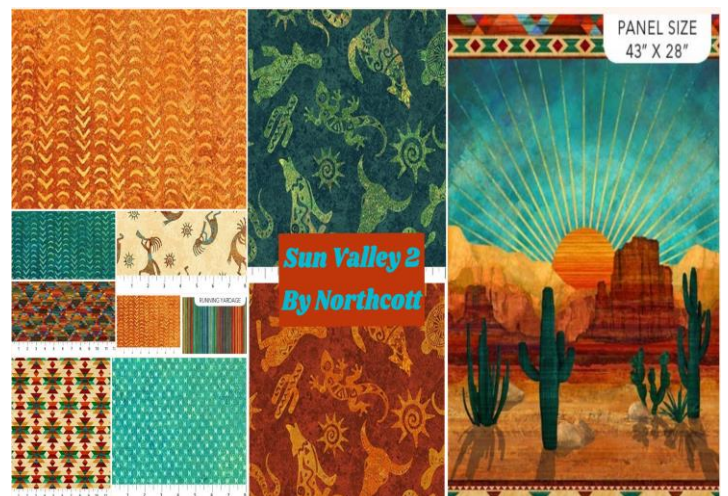

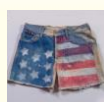

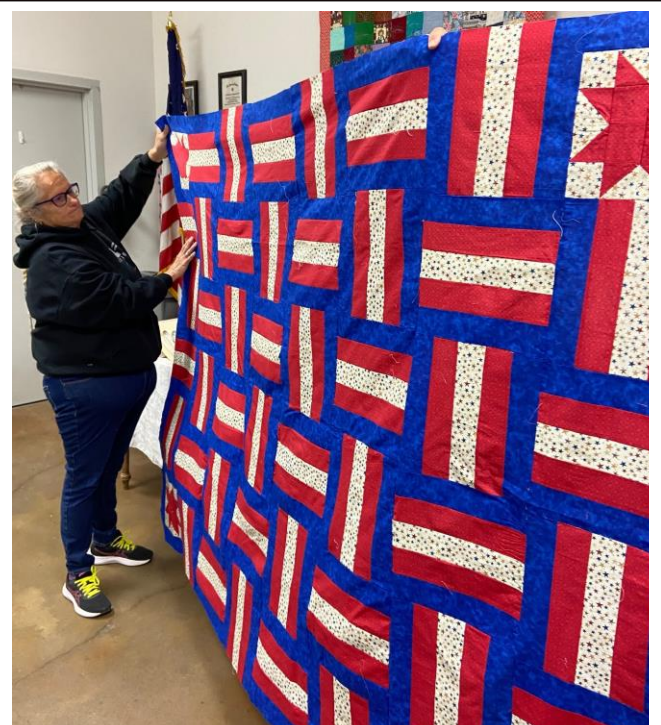
The QOVs from Bonnie Davis just keep getting better and better.

Sandy Shelley has been practicing with her quilting techniques to finish this beautiful Quilt of Valor.

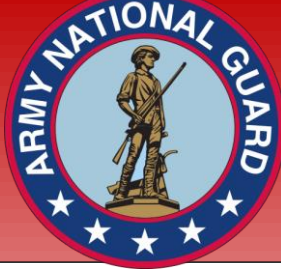


Jackie Gallagher added stars in the corners to finish off her QOV - made from a kit during the QOV sew-in weekend.
