

Handmade quilts will be on display as well as quilts and gift items for sale at the "Unique Boutique". Tickets for the Opportunity Quilt are available for \$1 or 6 for \$5. The drawing will take place at 3:00 on July 4th and you do not have to be present to win. Admission is free.

In conjunction with the quilt show will be a display of Quilts of Valor. Many members of the guild have joined this international organization dedicated to bringing comfort to our veterans. Last year, SWNMQG presented 40 quilts to veterans in Grant County as a thank you for their service to our country and community.

BEGINNING QUILTING


New to the quilting addiction? Come join us on on July 9th and 16th and 23rd for hands on help with everything from how to use a rotary cutter to finishing the binding.
