Pumpkin Pie

- 1 - 15 oz can of pumpkin
- 1 tsp. of cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp. each of ginger, nutmeg, mace, and salt
- 1/4 tsp. of clove
- 1 cup of dark brown sugar
- 3/4 cup each of whole milk and heavy cream
- 3 eggs

Preheat oven 425°, Blend all ingredients in blender. Pour into crust. Bake 15 min. Reduce temp to 350° and continue baking 35 to 40 min or until knife inserted 1 inch from crust comes out clean.






