



Kristi Porter is having way too much fun quilting. Here she shows an embroidered truck full of hearts and then a great assortment of squares and strips to make a colorful quilt.




Watching Nancy Tittman too much? Lawana Beem seems to have mastered the small block quilt. Below, a very impressive sampler block quilt with piano key borders.
