1 Day 2 Fabric Appliqué Class with Dana Keeler

Two fabrics, one spool of thread and a pattern. I will teach you how easy it is to make a wall hanging and it is quicker than you think. Using needleturn appliqué techniques on a 2 Fabric Appliqué Quilt. There are no templates, no numbering system and no positioning of small pieces.

One Day Workshop:

In this One day class you will be able to choose from several small 11" x 17" quilt designs created for this class.

This is a good introduction to the 2 Fabric Appliqué process as well as needleturn appliqué.

All skill levels welcome. No machines needed!

Supply List:

Appliqué fabric: 1 fat quarter

Background fabric: 1 fat quarter

choose two fabrics with STRONG contrast. They may be light

on dark, or dark on light.

Backing: 1 fat quarter (you will not need to bring this in class.

Milliners/Straw Needle size 10 or 11.

Thread for appliqué that matches your appliqué fabric (appliqué fabric is the fabric with the border in the photos)

Basting thread

Fabric scissors
Straight pins

Marking tools:

If you choose light appliqué fabric and can see the pattern through

1. Permanent, semi-permanent, or temporary pen that will

show on the right side of your appliqué fabric.

2. A light box if you would like. I will bring along some Pattern Transfer Paper for you to try.

Optional items: reading glasses, thimble, needle threader, portable light
