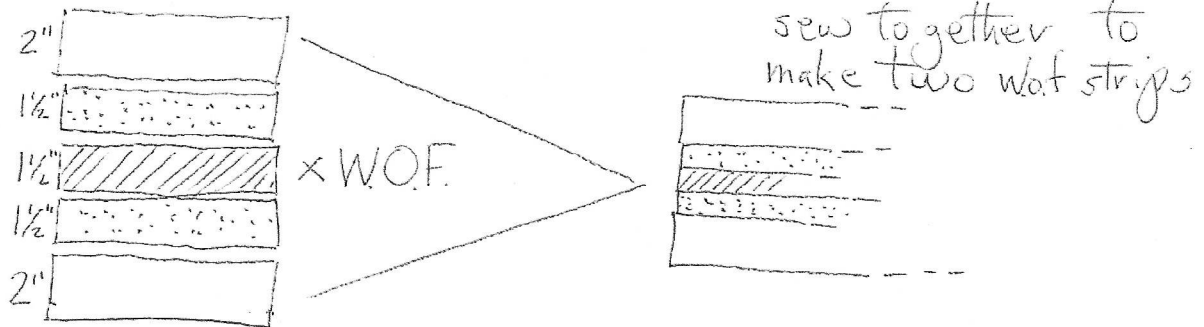


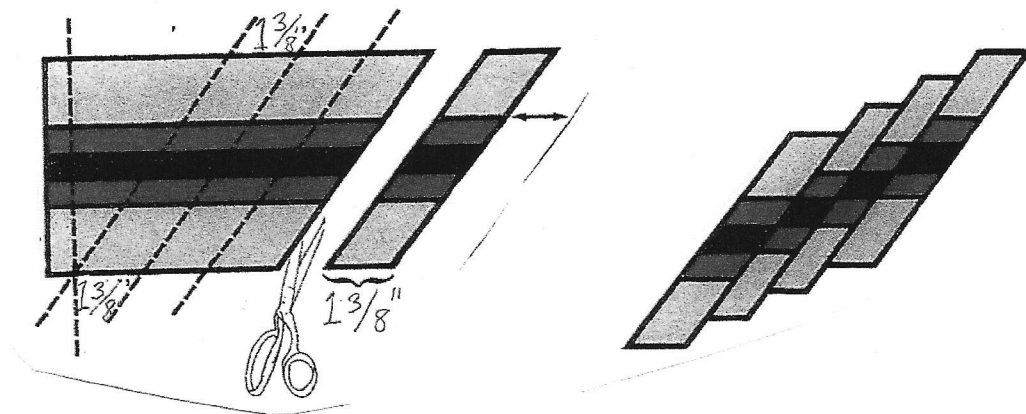
Seminole Strip #4

This is a strip with an interconnecting diamond pattern.
Be sure to make your corners meet accurately.
I suggest careful pinning before sewing.

1. Cut and sew 2 sets of strips, the Width Of Fabric (WOF).



2. Cut the strip on a 45 degree angle beginning on the right hand side. Sew and press seams either open or all to one side carefully, making sure that there are no tucks or folds. Then cut individual strips into pieces $1 \frac{3}{8}$ " wide.



3. Align the pieces, matching corners to make neat diamond shapes. Sew with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. You can iron all seam allowances open or to one side. When you have achieved your needed length cut off edges to leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
