

## MAZE / LETTER T

*Maze is the most intricate of alternate designs, yet is surprisingly simple to make. The use of narrow strips makes this small-scale pattern subtle and understated, a delicate contrast to bolder bands. It uses three fabrics. Once sewn into a quilt, the band measures 4 1/4" x 6 1/4" (104.8 cm x 15.9 cm).*

**STRIP SETS.** Cut nine strips of fabric, each measuring at least 28" (71.1 cm), as follows:

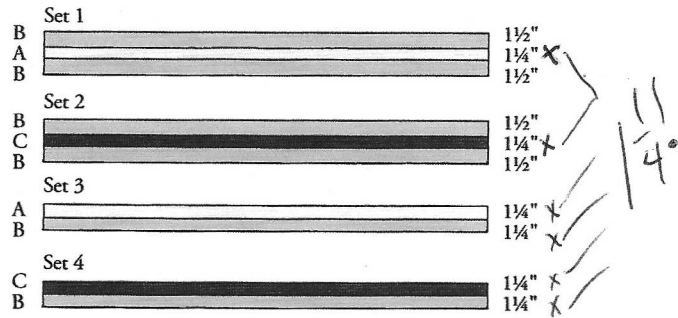
Two 1 1/4" (3.2 cm) strips of Fabric A

Two 1 1/4" (3.2 cm) strips of Fabric B

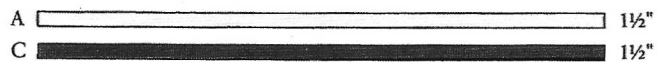
Four 1 1/2" (3.8 cm) strips of Fabric B

Two 1 1/4" (3.2 cm) strips of Fabric C

For use as spacers, cut a 1 1/2" (3.8 cm) strip each of Fabric A and Fabric C, selvage to selvage. Stitch the strips together lengthwise as shown to form four strip sets. Press seams toward darker fabric. Set the spacer strips aside.

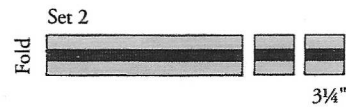
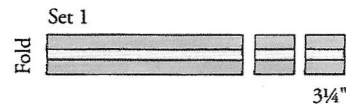


Cut and Stitch



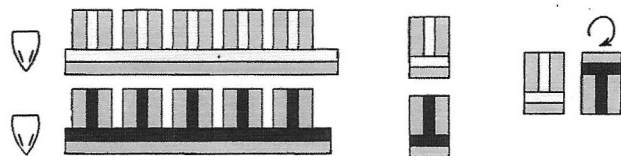
Cut Spacers

**SEGMENTS.** Fold Set 1 and Set 2 in half, end to end. Slice both into 3 1/4" (8.3 cm) segments.



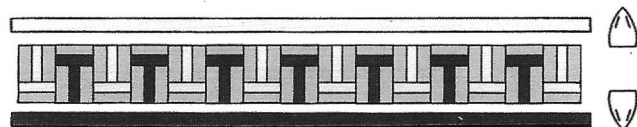
Fold and Slice

**SECTIONS.** Stitch segments made from Set 1 to Set 3. Stitch segments made from Set 2 to Set 4. Trim. Flip all sections made from Sets 2 and 4.

**BAND.** Stitch the sections edge to edge, alternating flipped and upright sections. To complete the Letter T band, stitch the 1 1/2" (3.8 cm) spacer strips of Fabrics A and C to either edge.
