

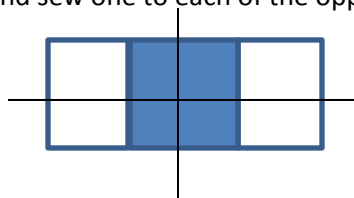


Scrappy Square in a Triangle (2016 WSQG Round Robin)

Materials... 5 “ Squares Assorted, 3 ½” strips neutral, 5 ½ “ strips main color

Directions

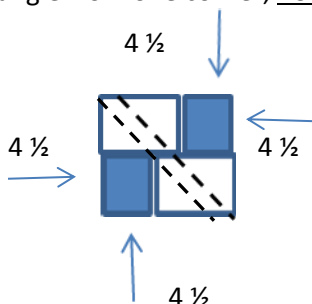
1) Cut 3 ½” strips into 3 ½ X 5” Rectangles (neutral background) and sew one to each of the opposite sides of the 5” squares. Cut in half, both directions making 4@ 2 ½” X 5 ½”



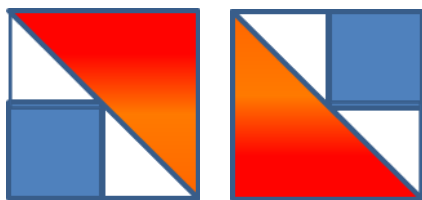
2) Sew any 2 of these rectangles together in alternate directions. (Making a 4 ½ X 5 ½ rectangle, the prints do not touch in the middle.)



3) With a marking pencil, draw the diagonal of a 4 ½” X 4 ½” square from each Background corner. Draw on the back of this piece. (45’ angle from one corner, **not** corner to corner, then opposite corner.)



4) Cut 5 ½ “ strips into 4 ½ “ blocks. Place a 5 ½” by 4 ½ “ main color rectangle under the marked piece, with right sides together. Stitch on the line and cut between the stitching lines. This will press open to be 4 ½’ square and you will have made 2 of them.



For Diagonal Rows alternate the blocks
